The Division is resting in the BELLOY sur SOMME Area after successful operations in the Line.

As there was reason to believe that a number of absentees was in the Area who were guilty of several robberies, a general "Round -up" throughout the Area was organised, resulting in the capture of a fair number of long standing absentees.

In other respects the behaviour of the troops has been excellent.
