

MOVE.

1. The 2nd. Brigade Group (less Motor vehicles) will be transferred by rail from the Third Army Area touthe Second Army Area, commencing on the 26th. inst. 5th. Battalion and 2nd. A.L.T.M. Battery, less "D" Coy., will entrain at AVELUY at 2100 on 26th. inst. "D" Coy. will entrain at 1700.

ENTRAINING & DETRAINING STATIONS.

2. The entraining and detraining stations will be AVELUY and CAESTRE respectively. On detraining, the Brigade will be concentrated in the St. MARIE - CAPPEL Area.

ROUTE.

3. From MEAULTE - E.LL.D.8.5. - E.4.B.3.3.- E.5.A.2.7.-W.29.C.O.2. - W.28.B.3.8. - Station.

STARTING POINT.

4. Junction of High Street and Bray Road. Head of column will pass Starting Point at 1900.

ORDER OF MARSH.

5. Signallers, Intelligence, Band, Headquarters, "C", "B", "A". Pioneers, A.M.C., Q.M. Btaff, Police.

ADVANCED BNTRAINING OFFICER.

6. Capt. CAUGHEY and one other rank mounted, will precede the Battalion and will report to Brigade Entraining Officer, Capt. CUTHBERT, at 1800 in order to supervise the entraining of the Battalion.

TRANSPORT.

- 7. Will move from Transport lines at 1715. Transport Officer will report to Capt. CAUGHEY at AVELUY and will arrange for a reconnaissance of the route to the station to be made. "A", "B", and "C" Coy. Cookers will move with Transport.
- A.L.T.M.Bty. 8. O.C. 2nd. A.L.T.M. Battery will report to Capt.CAUGHEY at AVELUY.

DETACHED COY. 9. "D" Coy. will move from billets at 1430 and entrain at 1657. O.C. "D" Coy. will report to Capt. CUTHBERT. Brigade entraining officer, at AVELUY, with Marching Out state in triplicate showing number of Officers, other ranks, Horses; and Vehicles.

Cooker will move with Coy. with meal in preparation. On arrival at CAESTRE Lt. MAKIN will report to Capt. F.L. MOORE and will detail 100 men to act as an unloading Coy. under Capt. MOORE'S instructions. Staff Captain will give particulars as to billets to be occupied by 5th. Battalion.
