

- 1. The Brigade has been ordered to take over the trenches at present held by the 103rs? Brigade of the 34th Division.
- 2. .. The Battellon will mark to OUTTERSTEENE on the 7th inst via HAZEBROUCK, BORRE and STRAZELLE and to ERQUINGHEM on the 8th inst via LE VERRIER, STEENWERCK and L'HALLOBEU
- 3. . The Battalion will pass at Starting point on theth inst at the road junction North of STEENHBECQUE, Square 15, b 05, vide sheet 36 A., at 9.33 a.m. The Battalion will be prepared to move off at 8 a.m. Companies will crose vowards the Canal.
- 4. . Reveille will be au 6 a.m. Breaklast at 6.30. All blankers are to be rotten tensminise in Water proof sheets, with the owner's names marked plainly thereon, and placed at the sine or the road outsides the Ballets by 6.30 a.m. O. O's Companies will detail sufficient men from each billet for the purpose of roading wagons, to which great attention must be pala. Company Officers' Baggage will be Loaded on the same Wagons as detailed for coy brankets.
- 5. . Water cottles are to be Illied and who midday meal to be carried.
- 6...O.Cs Companies will detail I N.C.O and I man per Coy to report to Battalion Heauquarters at 6 a.m. as Billeting party. The Interpretor will accompany will party. Lieut rims will be in enarge. Two days rations wall be car led.
- 7... Water Carts and Travelling Kitchens will have an escort of 2 men, all other vehicles one man, in addition to the Driver. These escorts will be supplied y the Company for Duty, with the exception of Travelling Kitchens and G.S. Wagons containing blankets, which will be supplied by each Company concerned. Escorts for Maltese cart and Officers' Mess cart will be supplied by Headquarters and A.M.C., respectively. One M.C.O. will be detailed from the Company for Duty to take charge of the whole escult.

EMERGENCY RATIONS. Company Commanders will be held personally responsible that these are not used by the men without the order of a Senior Officer.

1. On the night of the 30th April-1st May the 5th Brigade will hand ever Trench No 47 as far North as 1.31.c;5.31/2. to the 2nd Australian Infantry Brigade and will take ever from the 7th Australian Infantry Brigade Trench No 57 as far North as 1.20.d.4-1/2.1-1/2.

The frentage held by the 5th Australian Infantry Brigade will then comprise trenches 48 to 57 inclusive. This frentage will be

sub-divided as under:-

"A" Battalien frentage from trench 48 to 52 both inclusive.
"B" Battalien frontage from trench 53 to 57 both inclusive.

2. (a) "A" Battalien will hand trench 47 to 2nd Australian Infantry Brigade and take ever trench 52 from "B" Battalien on the night of the 30th April-1st May.

(b) "B" Battalien will hand ever trench 52 to "A" Battalien and take ever Trench 57 frem 7th Australian Infantry Brigade on the night of

the 30th April-1st May.

- 3. Seconds in Command of "A" and "B" Battalions will arrange between themselves re relief of trench 52.
- 4. "B" Cey. new in Reserve in the BOIS GRENIER LINE will take ever trench 57, and that perties of 56 new held by the 7th Brigade. starting to move at 8 e'clock via Shaftesbury Avenue-Haymarket and Support Line, thence along Communication Trench leading from Support Line to Firing Line on the left of "A" Company.

"D" Company when relieved by the 18th Battalien will move into Reserve in the BOIS GRENIER Line.

The Relieving Coy will move by Plateens at 5 minutes interval.

- 5. Snipers and Bembers of "B" Company will report at "Stand to" on the morning of the 30th inst to the Officer Commanding Company they are relieving and will remain on duty until their Company takes ever the trenches on the night of the 30th April-1st May.
- 6. The Battalien Signalling Officer will arrange for the necessary Signallers to report to the Officer Commanding Company that is being relieved during the afternoon of the 29th inst, and will remain on duty until their Company takes ever the trenches on the night of the 30th April-1st May. He will also take the necessary steps to have Trench 57 placed in direct communication with Battalien Headquarters at once.
- 7. One Officer per Cempany and one N.C.O. per Plateen will report to new trenches on afternoon of April 29th to learn all about brenches they are taking ever. These N.C.Os. will remain there during night of 29th-30th April. They will act as guides for their plateens on night of 30th April-1st May.
- 8. An inventory of all trench stores, S.A.A. Grenades, etc, including these enumerated in Company Log Books will be made out in quadruplicate by Company Commanders that are being relieved. Receipts will be obtained and given for all stores taken over or handed ever.

 1 copy of such inventory will be retained by Os.C. outgoing and incoming Companies. 2 copies will be forwarded to Battalian Headquarters, one of these will be sent to 5th Brigade Headquarters by 12 noon on let May.
- 9. Defence schemes, LegBooks, plans, Photographs etc, will be handed ever to relieving Company Commanders and receipts obtained. "B" Battalien will similarly take ever from 7th Aust. Infantry Brigade, all such decuments for trench 57.

10. The Engineer unleading and carrying parties for the night of 30th April-1st May will be found as under:-

> Fer "B" Battalien, by 19th Battalien. This party will not commence work until 10 p.m.

- 11. No Transport will cross the BAC ST MAUR ARMENTIERES Railway until 9 p.m. 30th April-let May.
- Officers Commanding Companies will notify Battalien Headquarters by wire when relief is completed.
- The erdinary relief of the Brigade will not take place until the 13. nights of May 1st and 2nd for "A" and "C" Battalions and May 2nd and 3rd for "B" and "D" Battalions.
- Company Commanders will see that trenches are left in a clean state 14. for the incoming treeps.
- Until further netice, all steres will be dumped by the Transpert at 15. the feet of Shaftesbury Avenue as usual.
- Companies will make the usual arrangements for the conveyance of 16. their rations to their different lines.
- "A" and "B" Companies will draw water from the Cottagge leading off 17. PARK ROW AVENUE, known as Burnt Cottage on the Map.
