CENSORSHIP.
919.

Regimental censorship of letters will be discontinued forthwith. Correspondence will still be liable to examination at the Base and all ranks are reminded that the censorship orders are still in force, except as regards those orders cancelled by B.R.O. 205.

If the examination at the Base shows that breaches of the censorship Orders are common in any units, it will be necessary to re-impose regimental Censorship on those units.

2. All letters and postcards must bear a censor stamp, except those posted in accordance with the latter portion of Censorship Orders, para. 30.

3. All letters and postcards will bear in the left hand bottom corner of the address side the name and rank, if any, of the writer. They will be handed closed to the officer in charge of the censor stamp, and will not be opened by him except for the purpose of identifying writers who have failed to comply with this order.

4. The issue of Green Envelopes will be discontinued forthwith.

5. Regimental censorship of parcels and telegrams will be maintained as heretofore.

6. For the purpose of interpreting "Censorship Orders for Troops in the Field" the term "franking" will be taken to mean the endorsement of the name and rank of the writer as indicated above, except as regards parcels.

Leave may be granted to places in Belgium as follows:

LEAVE.
920.

(a) In lieu of leave to the United Kingdom for a period not exceeding 16 days. Vacancies will be taken out of the allotment of leave to the United Kingdom.

(b) For periods not exceeding 10 days' absence from unit under the same conditions as leave is granted to places in K.M. France. No allotment of leave vacancies will be given, and numbers allowed to proceed on leave will be limited at the discretion of General Officers Commanding Armies, Corps, L. of C. Area, R.A.F.D.G.T. and Director of Forestry.

(3) Reporting Arrival.- (a) All officers under the rank of Brigadier-General and all other ranks on leave, if staying or detained for a night at any place at which British troops are stationed, will report personally on arrival to the D.A.P.M. If there is no D.A.P.M., all ranks will report to the Senior British Officer stationed there.

At Brussels Officers will report to Commandant, British troops and other ranks to the D.A.P.M., 78, Rue du Marche' aux Herbes.

(b) All officers under the rank of Brigadier-General & all other ranks granted leave involving permission to stay overnight, or who are detained overnight, at places in Belgium where no British troops are quartered, will report to the Belgian Commandant or ~~XXXXXXXX~~ Gendarmerie and present their passes for endorsement.

(5) Leave granted to organized Parties of troops to visit Places of Interest.- In all cases in which leave is granted to organized parties to visit places of interest and the leave involves the spending of one or more nights at a place, notification of the numbers proceeding, the period of leave and the name of the Officer or N.C.O i/c of the Party will be communicated beforehand to the D.A.P.M. or Senior British Officer at the place to which the party is proceeding.



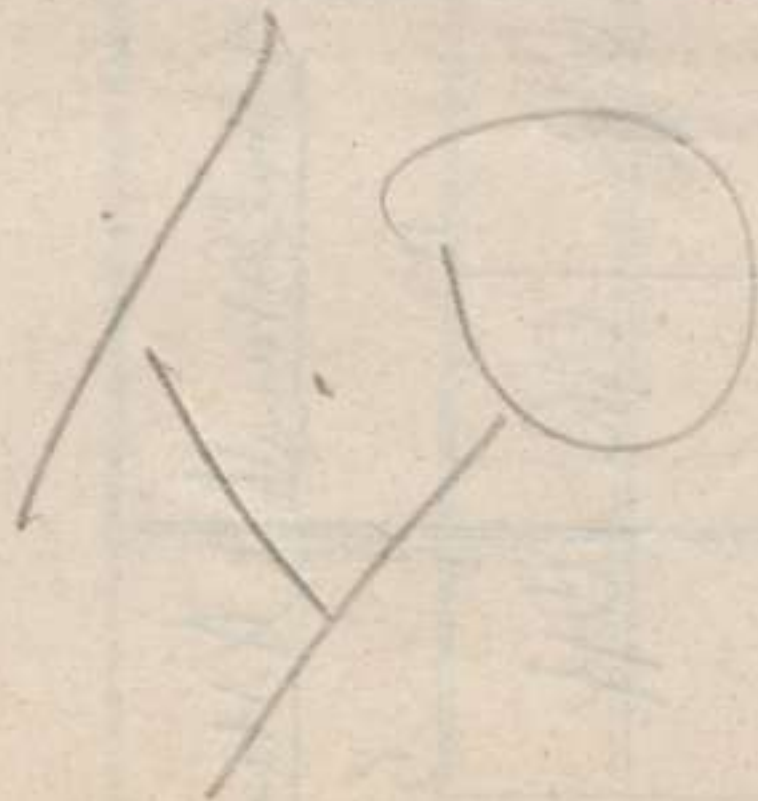



The condition of the men as regards fitness is very good. Training has been only very light and men's condition has been maintained by organized games.

Health of the Battalion has been very fair and during the month there were sixteen evacuations. The most prevalent condition in the unit has been Chyza, but none seems enough to warrant an evacuation. Accidental Injuries and Influenza, head the list of evacuations, there being four from each cause.

In accordance with demobilization instructions an examination of the whole unit has been done but there were only very few men found to have any complaint and in most cases none that would hinder them from returning to their former occupations.

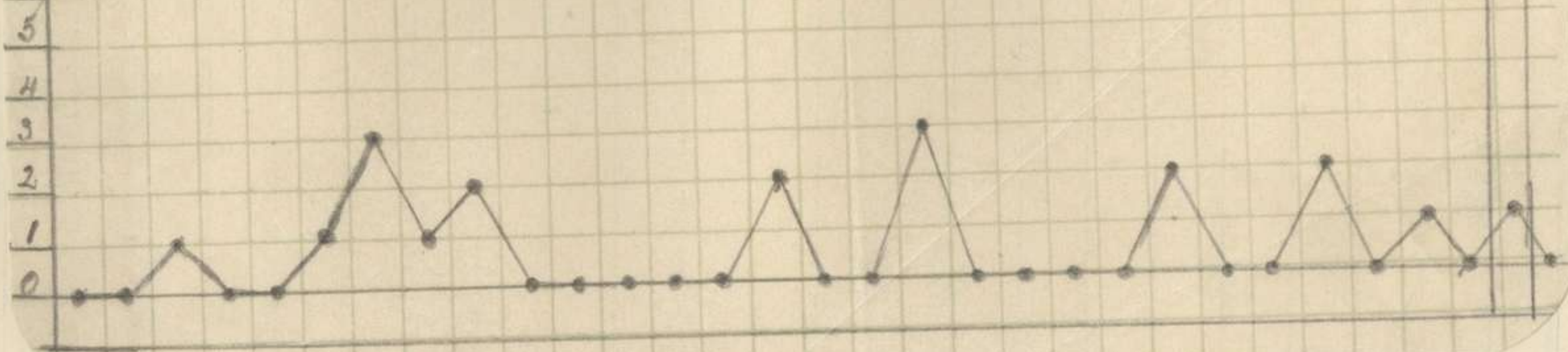


Evacuation Chart

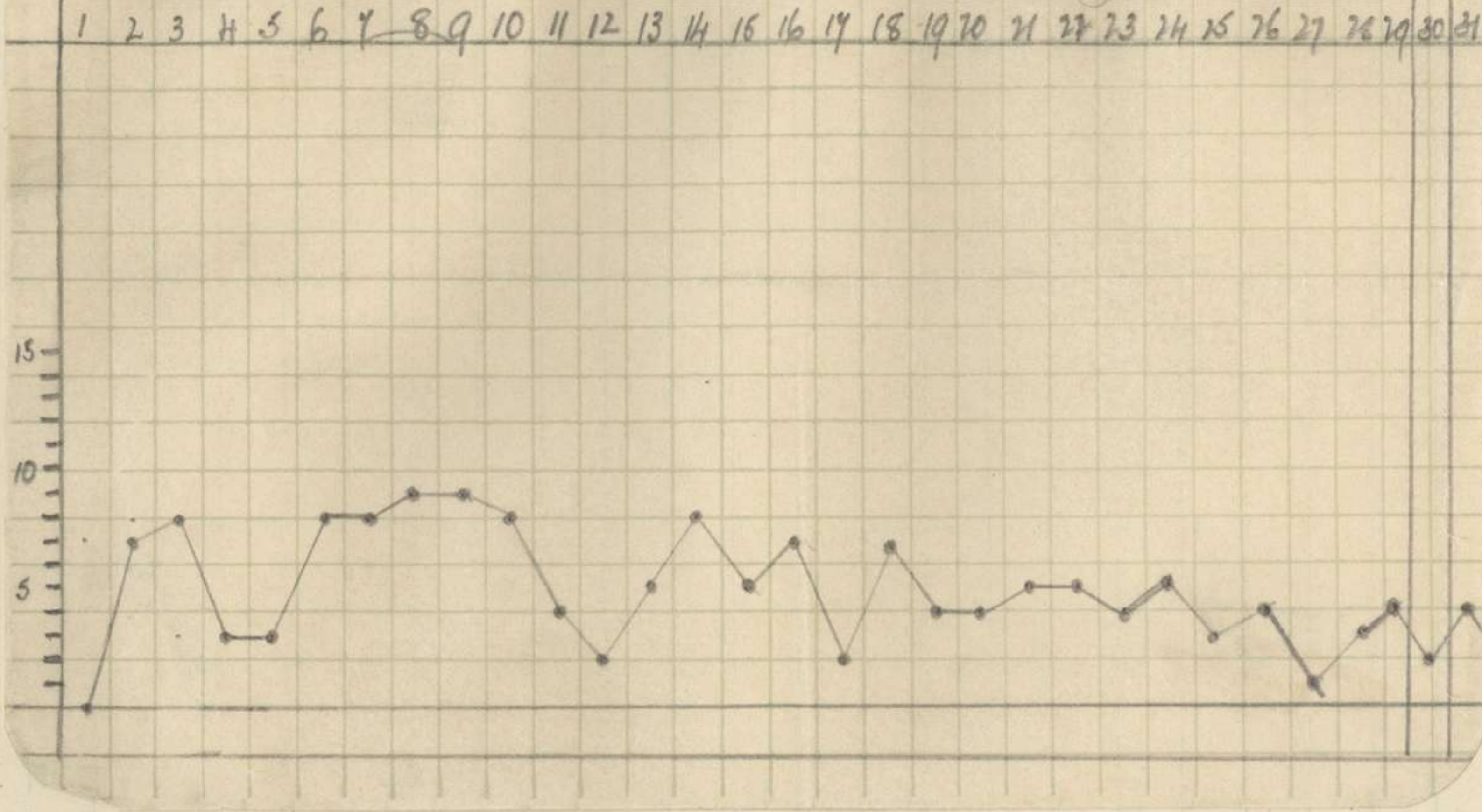
