

Birsalem. Kilo.295. April 1st.

1. OPERATIONS.

- 0754. XXIst Corps wire. Situation report. About 100 enemy advancing towards Kh el Ikba and Company in artillery formation E. of Rafat dispersed. 2230 Post on hill in A.14.a. attacked by bombers. Enemy quickly driven back. Considerable artillery fire against left of 52nd Division Sector. (G.610).
- 0815. XXth Corps wire. Situation report. Shea's Group last night. N.Z.M.R. Brigade at cross roads one mile east of Ain es Sir. 2nd L.H. Brigade and R.H.A. Battery at Es Salt, 181st Brigade and Mountain Brigade at Ain es Sir. 2/17th London Regt. at Ain el Jiria. 2/18th London Regt. on road 4 between Ain es Sir and Ain el Jiria. 179th Brigade and 3rd L.H. Regt. at Es Salt. 1st L.H. Brigade less 1 Regt., 1 battalion 158th Brigade and 1 L.A.C. Battery between Es Salt and Umm es Shert. 180th Brigade, less 3 battalions, at Nimrin. I.C. Brigade at Nimrin. 1 Battalion 180th Brigade at Howeij. All quiet during night. Withdrawal recommenced 0430. On 10th Division front between 2030 and 2230 enemy rifle fire from 099.B.20 and slight shelling. (G.256).
- 1303. XXIst Corps wire. Corps Headquarters now open at new site. (1).
- 1917. XXth Corps wire. Situation report. Shea's Group report following situation this evening. 181st Brigade about 127.V.6. central. 179th Brigade at Es Salt both brigades withdrawing to Shunit Nimrin tonight. 180th Brigade between Shunit Nimrin and El Howeij. I.C.C. Brigade Shunit Nimrin area. N.Z.M.R. Brigade withdrawing tonight on Shunet Nimrin by road No.4. Remainder of mounted troops no change in position. Only interference was by party of about 200 Turks who attacked rearguard passing through Ain es Sik and were easily beaten off. (G.264).
- 2157 XXth Corps wire. 158th Brigade Group withb266th Brigade R.F.A. attached will march on April 3rd to Talat ed Dumm, on 4th to Jerusalem, on 5th to Ramallah. On 6th it will come under orders of 74th Division and will march to 74th Division area. Field Ambulance now at disposal of 60th Division will revert to 158th Brigade on evening of 2nd inst. Platoon now at Rujm el Bahr will be relieved to-morrow 2nd inst. by party of not less than 1 officer and 20 other ranks from I.C.C. Brigade. (G.268).

 Amman bridge captured by Sherif Ali Ibn Hussin, 15 of guard being captured. Bridge to be destroyed by dynamite. (67101/34).
