" 20.	First route march 8 miles Boots & feet examined and satisfactory Lt.Col.Dawson 2nd in command appointed Brigade Major and Major Walker assumed position as acting 2nd in Command.	B.O.56.
" 17/25th	Battn completing Musketry course Table A Physical Drill Platoon and Company Drill in close order & some work in Extended Order.	
" 26.	Second route march to CUSH'S CROSSING about 15 miles with loaded Transport - 8 men fell out.	B.O.62.
" 28.	Recd. wire from Brigadier 7th Brigade re his procedure from Freemantle leaving Melbourne on June 2 to join Transport there.	
" 29.	Received copy of instructions as O.C.Transport AA60 (AENEAS) Battn. marched through Brisbane.
