

18th Bartalion H.J. 7. August 1915. 18 Am. Drany 1915 Aug 19. Lemnos at Day light; hundred of "Shundred and wessels here sprokeched by a borkeds net amines about 4 mls long. anchored outside boom for hreakfast's then went into harbour Saubloris, L'helson. Conwall anchored near Shore. heard we were Sarling at once Leveryone ietectid. lug 207 18th Ball- 019th Ball- moned away al-Friday & Sundown in Remaniah (Egyptimmail boat our transport from Lemnos lo anyac) We go lomanow - very durby ship Theo & filth every where, I sloway aus en board. lug 20 Bout alongside 1/2m. Keft-Lemnos about 3.45 pm. Kan at 15 Knob in darkness. Lun Plashes & roay of cannon at 9.13 pm By halle on Saw warhoats in a chin duy 22. Landed at daylight-no casualties, by one of even wounded in Stomach reas Watgon's Pier. Roas of cannon a inwrect

Aug 26th Went round brenches on Russell Yop Saw periocope nelles in use. hlead aust. levery where. Hear 310 attacked on 8th 4237 Killed. We take over at hoon. Youk charge of not lost. Made demonst. at 9.15 pm. Turks nephed vigorously. about 10, voo vads amm. Used up. Mug27th WI am old 75 drove a hole in bourgun position. at 14.50 a demonstration Fook place but Turks ready. Good Surping along front' Set Parne had magazine blown of. no damags. at-16. a deketmuned attack was made onour legs. hyddite cohnaprel rained who m 9.5 hummed. Fancy our men O.18. Heavy finng en front. 75 at it. Aug 28th Everything quel- on Ruttel Hop. action on left thell propressing with rumours of all sorts flying round footfover furthers past of trenches. no Casualty Saw Ten Birdword. Aug 29th Coverything quiet. German plane dropped bombs, no damage done have got good hole Cov Sniping. Saw Wanhout on fine



## 18th BATTALION. A.I.F.

Aug. 30th.

Turks very quiet - Had shots at

German Officer (target found to be a

dummy). Enemy shelled Div.H.Q. this

afternoon but issue of rations went on.

In the night several scares & 2 rockets

sent up. C.Coy. in trench, one shot himself
in leg & other ran bayonet in shoulder.

Aug. 31st. Got a sniper before breakfast (0400).

Putting up a 3 pounder. Got two
more at close range (40.3 pr in position)
Turks made demonstration tonight
but we scared them off in short order.
