

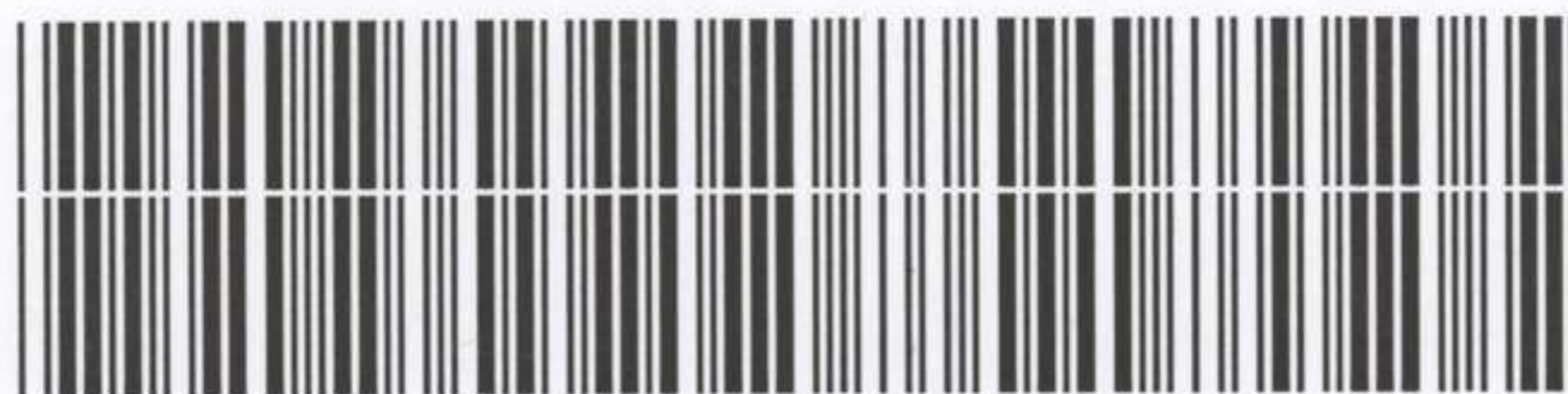

Large fatigue parties supplied regularly for the work of rebuilding the old front line and communication trenches under the direction of the 8th Field Coy. A large number of men supplied and attached to the 8th Bde. Mining Co which was engaged in the work of deep dug out construction. Coy. training was actively carried out particular attention being paid to rifle grenade training. Bathing parades regularly held.</p> <p>16/31 Bn. relieved 31st Bn. in the line at FLEURBAIX where the Coys. did regular tours in the front line. The whole tour consisted of holding the line, the up keep of the trench system and its reconstruction.</p>	<p></p>
