1. The 2nd Aust. Infantry Brigade Group will move by rail from the LONG to the EPEHY, ROISEL, TINCOURT Area by train on the 6th and 7th November, in accordance with attached Time Table.

2.(a) For the purposes of the move the Brigade Group will consist of -

2nd Aust. Inf. Bde.
2nd A.L.T.M. Bty.
2nd Field Coy. Engrs.
No.2. Coy. M.G. Battalion.
2nd Field Amb.
No.4 Section Signal Coy.
M.G. Divisional Engrs.
S.A.A. Section, D.A.C.
Mobile Vet. Section.
No.3. Coy. Div. Train.
Div. Salvage Coy.

(b) The 3th Battalion will be clear of VILLERS sous AILLY by 2 p.m. 6th instant.

3.(a) Loading parties, each of one Company/^{of 2} Officers and not less than 50 Other Ranks with cooker, will be detailed by C.Os 2nd Field Coy. Engrs., 7th Battalion and 5th Battalion at HANGEST, POISSY REMY and LONGPRE respectively. These parties will report to the R.T.Os at the stations at which they are to work four hours prior to the time set down for the departure of the first train conveying the Brigade Group from that station. They will travel by the last train conveying the Brigade Group leaving from their respective stations.

(b) Similar parties for unloading at EPEHY, ROISEL and TINCOURT will be detailed by C.Os 2nd Field Coy. Engrs, 6th Battalion and 8th Battalion respectively. These parties will travel by trains Nos.1, 2 and 3 respectively. All infantry loading parties will be in charge of a Captain - the Field Coy. will detail one officer only (subaltern)

(c) The Os.C. these parties will report to the R.T.O's at their respective stations as early as possible in order to obtain full information as to their duties. They will arrange with the Area Commandants concerned for their parties to be billeted as near as possible to the Railway Stations at which they will be required to work.

4. Major HASTIE, 'MC', 5th Battalion and T/Capt. G. STOBIE, 6th Battalion will represent the Brigade at LONGPRE and ROISEL respectively. The former will travel by train No.8. and the latter by train No.2. At all other stations the Os.C. the loading and unloading parties will represent the Brigade

5. Each Unit will prepare Marching Out states in triplicate showing the number of officers, Other Ranks, Horses (heavy and light), four and two wheeled vehicles, and bicycles. One copy of this state will be handed to the R.T.O. at least three hours prior to the departure of the train by which the unit is to travel, one to the O.C. Train and one to the Bde. representative.

6. Billeting parties (with bicycles) of One officer and 4 N.C.O.'s per Battalion and One Officer and one N.C.O.s from each Senior Unit of the Brigade Group (with the exception of 2nd Field Amb. and 2nd Field Coy. Engrs.) will travel on Train No.28 on arrival at ROISEL they will report to Staff Captain or his representative. 2nd Field Amb. and the 2nd Field Coy. Engrs. will be met at EPEHY and directed to billets.

7. (a) Infantry Transport will arrive at the Entraining Station three hours prior to the time of departure of the train by which it is to travel. Infantry personnel will arrive one and a half hours prior to the time of departure.

(b) Transport and personnel of all other units will arrive at the entraining station three hours before the time of departure of the train.

(c) All Units will be entrained half an hour prior to the time set down for the departure of the train.

8. Cs.C. Trains will see that the following instructions are carried out:-

- (a) No liquor will be allowed on the train.
- (b) Riding on steps or in any dangerous position is forbidden.
- (c) Troops will not be allowed to leave train at any time without permission of an officer or Senior N.C.O. To prevent this, picquets will be posted in the center and at each end of trains.
- (d) Troops, if given permission, may enter station buffets for the purpose of obtaining refreshments, but no liquor may be purchased. A picquet will be posted to prevent this and the proprietor will be warned that the place will be declared out of bounds should any attempt to sell same be made.
- (e) No personnel will be allowed in the brake vans at each end of the train nor on the roofs of coaches.
- (f) No covered trucks will be used for luggage.
- (g) Lewis Guns will be mounted on all trains for use, if necessary against hostile aircraft.

9. On the march to and from entraining and detraining stations, the following distances will be maintained:- between Battalions 500 yards, between companies 100 yards - between Unit and its transport 100 yards.

10. Brigade Headquarters will close at COCQUEREL at 9 p.m. on 6th November after which hour until arrival at ROISEL all communication should be sent to the Brigade Representative at LONGPRE (Major HASTIE, 'MO').

ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS issued in
connection with Brigade Order No. 132.

1. BILLETING. Guides will be provided (under Brigade Arrangements) to conduct units to Billeting Areas on detrainment.
2. AREA STORES. No Area Stores will be taken from the present Billeting Areas. Receipts will be obtained for all Area Stores returned to Area Commandants or Billet Wardens. Copies of these Receipts will be forwarded to this office by 1200 on 8th instant. All Peillassos drawn by units in the present area will be returned to D.A.D.O.S. by 1800 on 6th instant.
3. TRAINING AMMUNITION. Attention is directed to Fourth Army Routine Order No. 1642 of 14-1-18 which is republished herewith for information. In compliance with this order, Brigades will collect all surplus Training Ammunition into one Dump in their Brigade Area, and hand it over to the Area Commandant. Receipts will be obtained for all such Training Ammunition, Grenades, etc. handed over. A copy of these receipts will be forwarded to this office by 1200 on 8th instant.
4. TOWN MAJORS. All Town Majors found by units of the Division for the villages in the present Areas will rejoin their Units by 1800 on 6th instant and move with them.
5. TRANSPORT. Units will move with full Echelons of S.A.A., Grenades, Tools, etc.
Supply and baggage wagons will accompany units and ontrain with them.
All vehicles will be entrained fully loaded.
All Water carts will be entrained full.
Horses will be watered prior to entrainment.
6. SUPPLY ARRANGEMENTS. Units will refill twice on the 6th instant with rations for the 7th and 8th instants. These rations will be taken with units on the train. On the 7th, 2nd Brigade Group will draw at Detraining Stations for consumption on the 8th.
Should the Brigade Group move forward by Bus on the day following Detrainment, a supply of Dixies for cooking purposes and rations for the day following the day of the move by Bus will be taken on the Busses.
7. SURPLUS KIT. Attention is drawn to my 11/595 of 3-11-18 relative to the disposal of Units' surplus kits.

A Division before leaving a Training Area will collect and return all unexpended Ammunition and Grenades to the Area Dump, notifying Army "Q" and the Area Commandant by wire, the amount so returned.

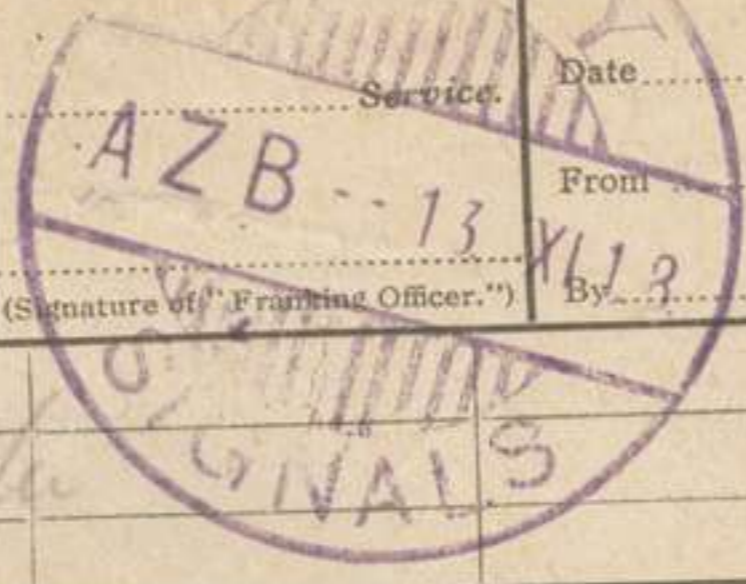
