

HENNEVEUX From 1/2/18 to 10/2/18.

The Battalion was spread over a very large area.

H.Qs. and Details at 4.D.4.8. 'A' Coy at Cross Roads,

4.D.2.9. 'B', 'D' and 'C' Coys in and around CREMAREST.

Each Coy carried on individual training under the supervision of Coy Commanders. The weather considering

the time of the year, was excellent.

HENNEVEUX AREA.

12/2/18/5/ Rain fell duringthe night and made the roads muddy, Abut later during the day it was fairly fine.

The Battalion was present at a Gas Demonstration to-day, given by the Div. and Bde Gas Officers, which included an attack by "Flammen werfer".

Lieut. W.L. DAVIES, M.C. and Lieut. A.M. MOORE

marched out on English Leave. Catt. MATHESON, (R.M.O.) and Lieut. J.H.LAPTHORNE, M.C. from English Leave.

AREA.

HENNEVEUX 13/2/18. Raining steadily all the morning. Route March postnoned until Thursday. We played the 28th Bn. at Football at Le WAAST, the players being taken over by the leave lorry. The 27th Bn. won easily.

> 14/2/18. Dull and cloudy day, slight misty rain towards evening. Cant. PIGGOTT (R.M.O.) relieving Cant. MATHESON, on English Leave, returned to 7th Field Ambulance. Bde Snorts postnoned indefinitely owing to rain.

> 15/2/18. Bright and sunny day. Bath parade for all Coys at new baths at BELLEBRUNE. Pay Day.

16/2/18. Lieut. J.O.JULGE to Aust Corps School

17/2/18. Frosty during the night. Sun quite warm towday. 'A' Coy played 'D' Coy football, 'A' Coy winning easily. 2/Lieut. R.H. HUGHES from School. Church Parade at BELLEBRUNE for 'A' Coy and H Q. followed by another service at CREMAREST for 'B', 'C' and 'D' Coys. Lieut. S.S. WOODS, M.C. from Corns School.

Very fine day. 18/2/18. 2/Lieut. STEWART, A.H. from School. Lieut. J.E. GATLEY to school.

19/2/18. Very fine day. The Battalion marched to Bde. Snorts grounds leaving BELLEBRUNE at 8.45 a.m. The Battalion won the aggregate of these sports.

20/2/18. Dull morning. A misty rain commenced to fall about noon, lasting most of the afternoon. During the morning the G.O.C., Gen. Sir W. BIRDWOOD inspected the Guard of Honour composed of the Model Plate oons of the 25th, 26th, 27th and 28th Bns. The G.O.C. afterwards presented the following Officer and O/Ranks with Ribands -
