

OPERATION ORDER NO.1,

BY LIEUTENANT COLONEL F.W.LE MAISTRE, COMMANDING.

INFORMATION. (1) (a). It is reliably reported that hostile troops are north of TUSSOOM.

(b). Our own troops have one Outpost Company at HABEITA Vabout 8 miles due East of Serapium Camp).

(3) INTENTION.

Outposts to cover and and 3rd Infantry Brigades will be established on semicircle with a radius of 1000 yards from perimeter of camp, with rear points resting on the Canal and with Habeita road as centre.

DISTRIBUTION. (3) (a) The Battalion will provide a section of an Outpost line covering the camp, south of and exclusive of Habeita road.

C. Company will gain and maintain connection with any defence troops on East or West Bank (c) of Canal.

A, B, and C Companies will provide Outposts. parading at 1530. Each man to carry 150 rounds S.A.A., one iron ration, and a full water bottle. Pack animals with tools will parade with each Company.

C. Company as No.1 Outpost Company will be responsible for about 1000 yards from Canal exclusive in a semicircular direction towards

Habeita road. A. Company as No. 2 Outpost Company, frontage approximately 1000 yards in a similar direction. B. Company as No. 3 Outpost Company, approx-

imately 1000 yards from A. Company to Habeita road exclusive.

LINE OF RESISTANCE. The picket line is line of resistance.

INLYING PICKET.

D. Company will act as Inlying Picket, furnishing two sentries over arms and necessary reliefs. No.1 to be posted at C.O's. tent, No.2 at the tent of Officer commanding D. Company.

LIGHTS.

No fires to be lit. No lights or smoking (6) after 1000 1900.

(7) REPORTS.

To C.O's. tent, Serapium camp. First report/to be in by 1645.

(1) (a) No further information is to hand re hostile troops INFORMATION. reported north of TUSSOOM. (b) Our own troops have one Outpost Company at HABEITA

Outposts to cover 2nd and 3rd Infantry Brigades will (3) INTENTION. be established on semicircle with a radius of 1000 yards from perimeter of camp, with rear points resting on the Canal and with Habeita road as centre.

DISTRIBUTION. (3) (a) The Battalion will provide a section of an Outpost line covering the camp, south of and exclusive of Habeita road.

(b) D. and B. Companies will provide Outposts, parading at 1600, each man to carry 150 rounds S.A.A., unexpende portion of day's ration, and full water bottle. Pack

animals will parade with each Company.

(4) (a) D. Company as No.1 Outpost Company will be respons-FRONTAGES. ible for about 1500 yards from Canal exclusive in a semicircular direction towards Habeita road.

(b) B. Company as No. 2 Outpost Company, frontage approximately 1500 yards, continuing the semicircle to Habeita road exclusive.

D. Company will gain and maintain connection with any defence troops on East or West Bank of Canal.

The picquet line is the line of resistance. LINE OF (5) RESISTANCE.

A. Company will act as Inlying Picquet, furnishing (6) INLYING two sentries and necessary reliefs. No.1 sentry to be PICQUET. posted at C.O's. tent, No.2 sentry at tent of officer commanding A. Company.

No fires to be lit. No lights or smoking after (7) LIGHTS. 1830.

To C.O's. tent, Serapeum camp. First report, with (8) REPORTS. sketch, to be in by 1630.

(1) (a) No further information is to hand re hostile I NFORMATION. troops north of TUSSOOM. (b) Our own troops are out as follows: -

One Battalion in position about 8 miles due east of Serapeum Camp, one Outpost Company at HABEITA, working party of one company at rail-head. (THIS LATTER PARTY MAY BE EXPECTED TO RETURN TO CAMP

VIA HABEITA ROAD SHORTLY AFTER DARK).

Outposts to cover and and 3rd Infantry Brigades (3) INTENTION. will be established on semicircle with a radius of 1000 yards from perimeter of camp, with rear points resting on the Canal and with Habeita road as centre.

> (3) (a) The Battalion will provide a section of an Outpost line covering the camp from point on Canal about 1000 yards south of camp in a semicircle to and exclusive of Habeita road.

(b) C. Company will provide Outposts to parade at Each man will carry 150 rounds S.A.A., 1600. unexpended portion of day's ration, and full water bottle. Pack animals of C. and D. Companies, with tools, will parade with Outpost Company.

(c) Touch will be maintained with defence troops on Canal and Outposts of 3rd Brigade north of Habeita road.

The picquet line is the line of resistance. (4) LINE OF RESISTANCE.

D. Company will act as Inlying Picquet, furnishing (5) INLYING two sentries and necessary reliafs. No.1 sentry PIGQUET. is to be posted at C.O's. tent, and No.3 sentry at tent of Officer commanding D. Company.

No fires to be lit. No lights or smoking after (6) LIGHTS. 1830.

(7). To C.O's tent, Serapeum Camp. First report, REPORTS. with sketch, to be in by 1630.

The 5th Battalion and one section of No. 2 Field Company QUTE (1) Engineers, with Camel Convoy, will move from Serapeum tomorrow 29th inst. and bivouse at site selected in centre sub-section of 2nd Brigade defence section.

(3) The units will move at 0000. TIME.

DISTRIBUTION. (3). Advance Guard, O.C., Capt.D.A.Luxton. B.Company less two platoons.

B. Company.

Main Body. The Battalion will move in column of

route in three columns as follows: -

Centre Column: -leading, A. Company, all pack horses. Right Column, moving at 10 paces interval on right of rear unit of Centre Column, D. Company 5th Battalion, one section Field Engineers, and all wheeled transport.

Left Column, moving 10 pages interval on left of rear unit of Centre Column, C. Company, Camel Convoy, Baggage party (2 sections B. Company). A second Camel Convoy will join this Column after passing rail-head. Rear Guard. O.C. Lieut F.L. Moore, one platoon

B. Company, one empty limber (for sick).

COMMUNICATIONS. (4) Headquarter's Signalling Section will be responsible for maintaining communication between protective units and main body, and also with Brigade Headquarters at Serapeum during march and while in bivousc.

> Rear Guard will be responsible for collecting of all stragglers and for detailing necessary escorts in event of

any breakdowns.

Strict march discipline will be observed. No increasing of pace permitted.
