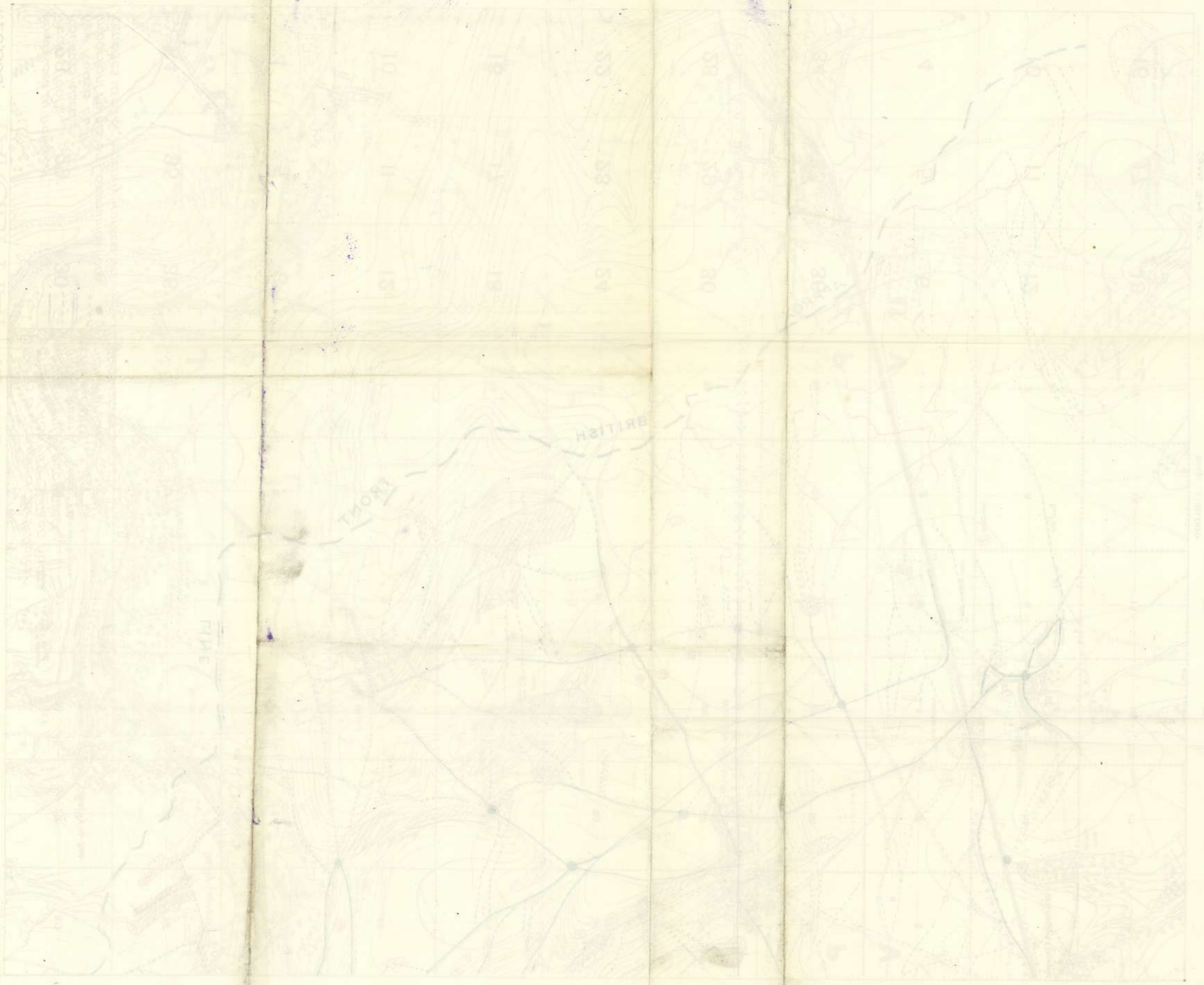
FIELD SURVEY OF P.E. (S.P. 1) 1:20,000

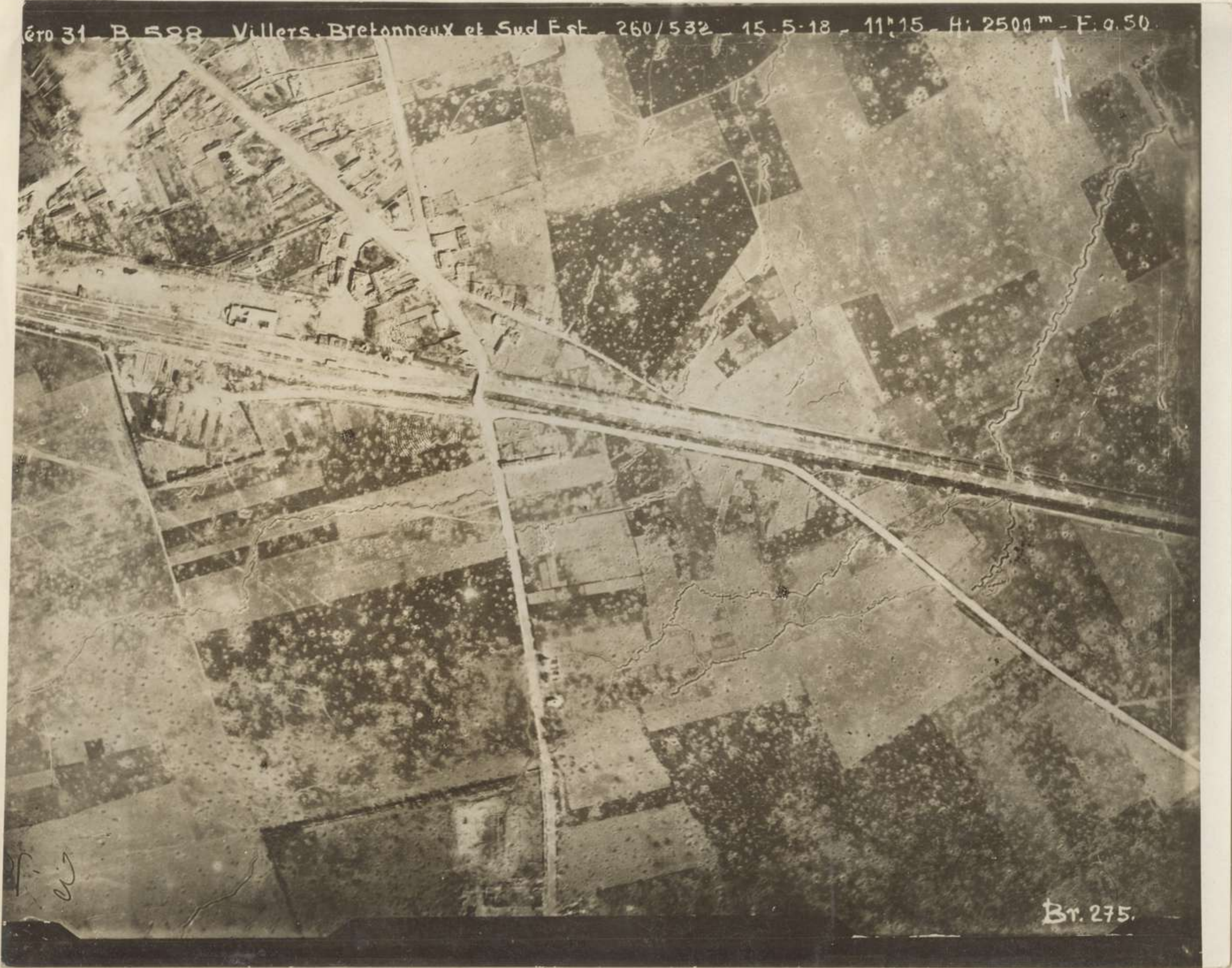

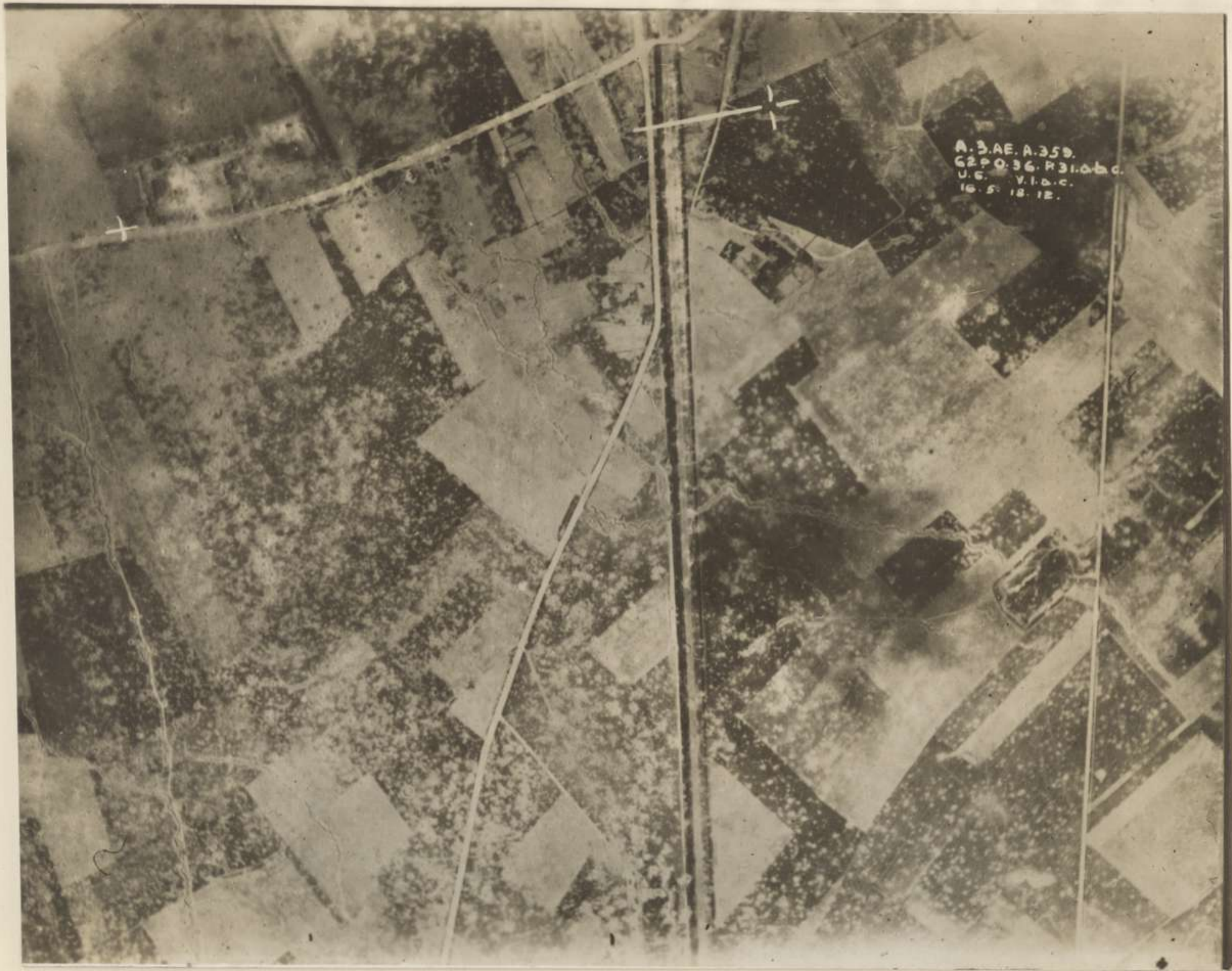

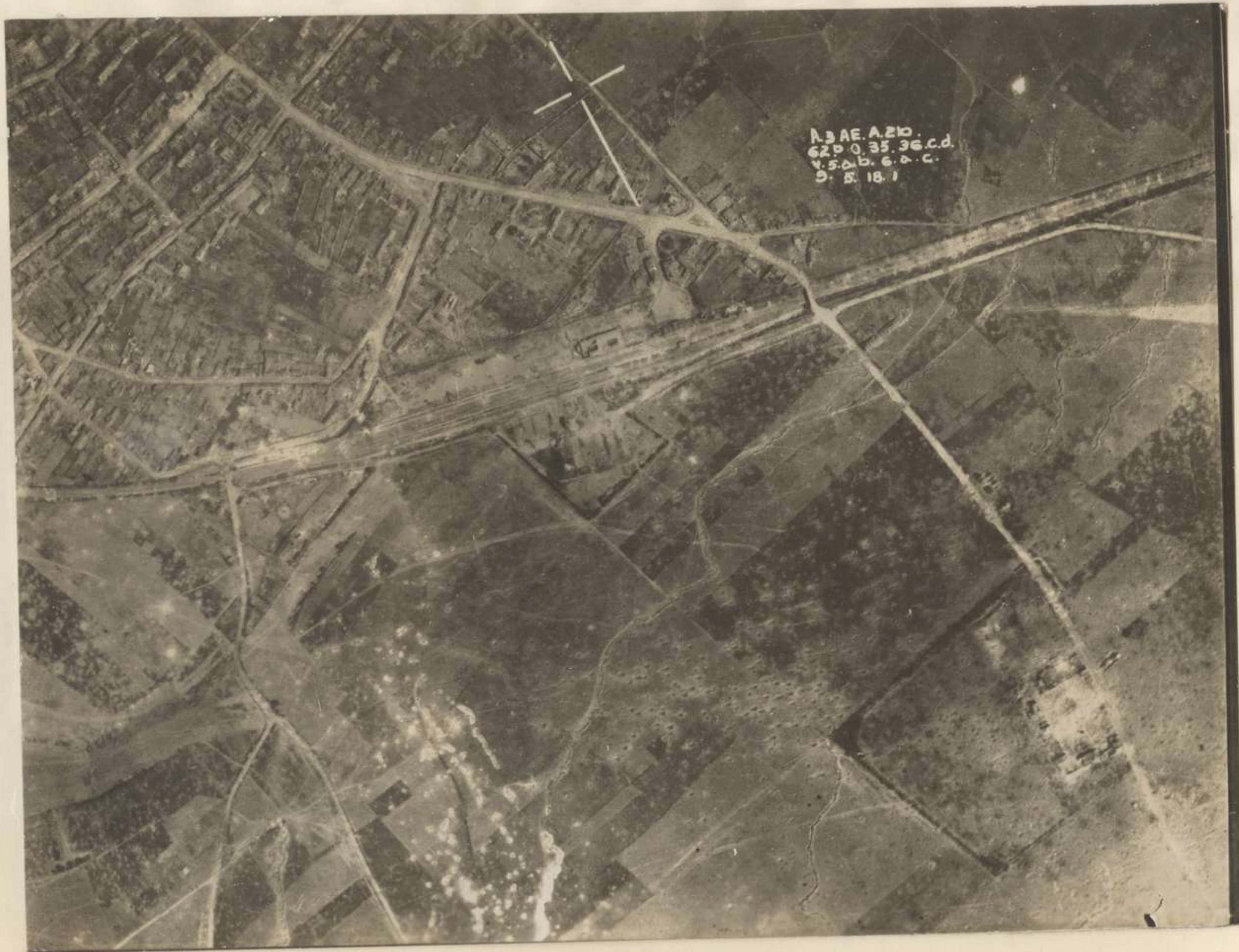

The following is taken from "The Bulletin" dated 17th January, 1918.

It is a reprint of a German magazine, written by that amiable person MAXIMILIAN HARDEN.

The magazine was the "ZUKUNFT", picked up from a German Planter's table in NEW GUINEA.

" We have the greatest contempt possible for any human to possess, for the AUSTRALIAN, doing as little work as he can, spending his substance in concubinage, in sport, in gambling (which is his religion) and in drinking.

" We who claim to be honest laugh at the quizzotic bravery of the Australian, whose enthusiasm carried him away to face our God-led arm.

" We will break the hearts of unionists for all time. We are gratified at the success of our Agents in AUSTRALIA and the powers of German gold. Those Germans who, like JUDAS, have turned against the FATHERLAND in its hour of trial will be suitably dealt with. Those who have stood firm and are now interned will be placed over their captors and in high administrative positions.

" The AUSTRALIANS are the most ignorant people in the wide world. They cannot speak or write correctly the British language.

" Our propoganda in the land of the Southern Cross has been most successful.

" We will scatter them over the face of the earth, whilst we will retain their women in AUSTRALIA to be mothers of a new German race "in the great Pacific".

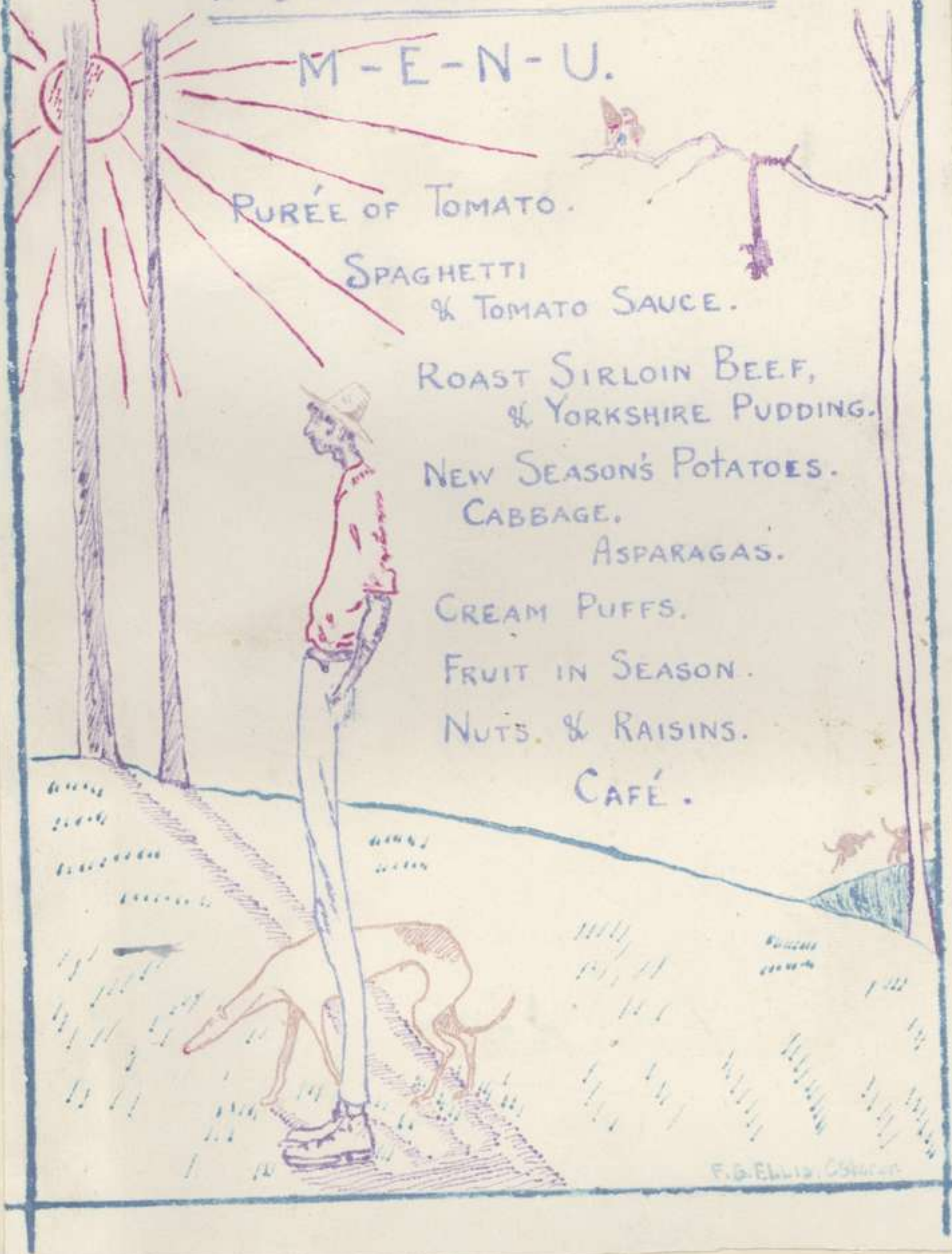

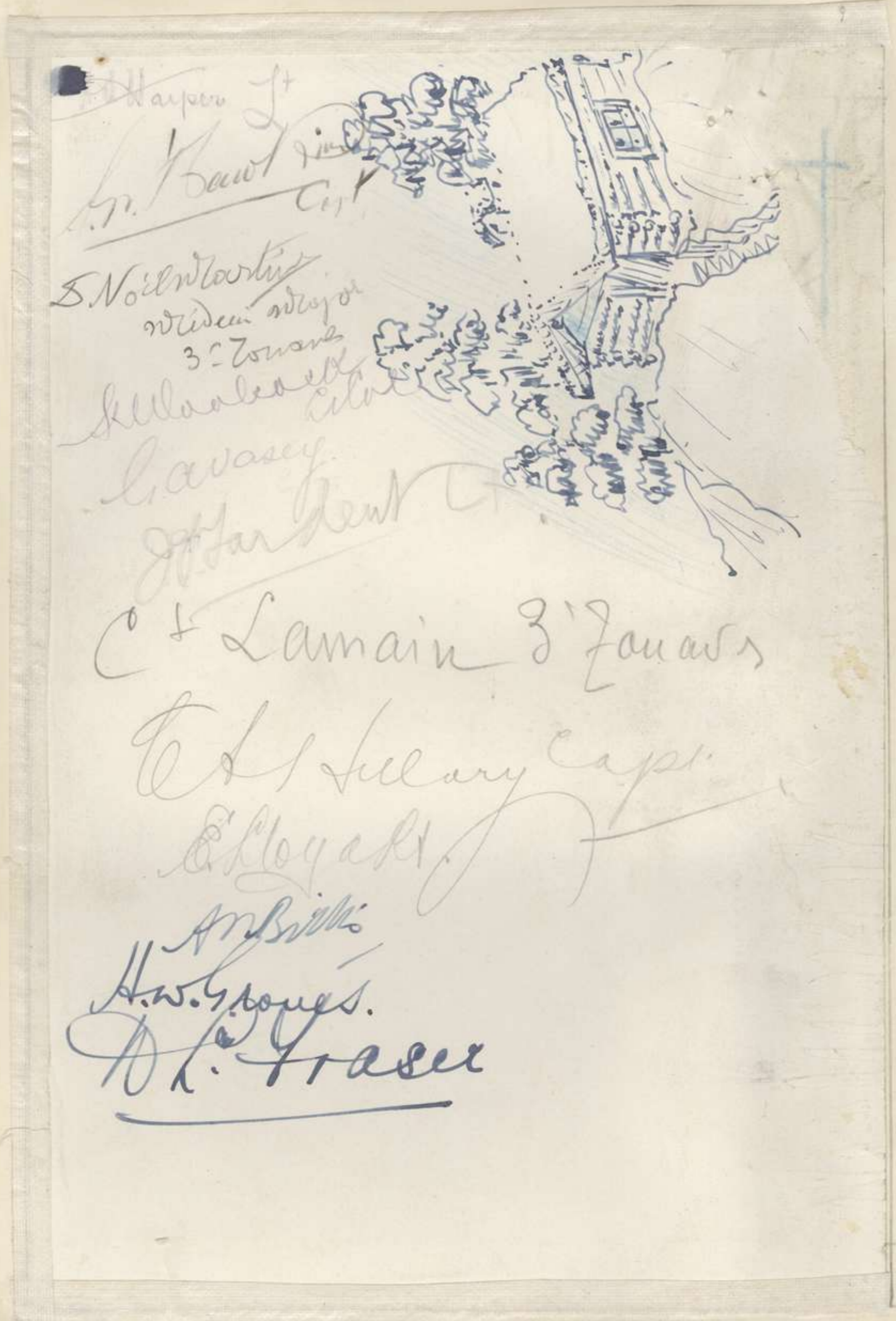

The French Col. wishes me to convey his very warmest appreciation for the wonderful barrage put up by our "Emma Gees" in support of last night's stunt. They think it was something quite "out of the box" I suppose. Gain "Lapps" told you this morning how another party went out and stayed in the post till 4 a.m. but no Bosche came back for their M.G. They absolutely ratted the trenches clean but could get no identification of any kind. About 15 shells fell about the Coy. H.Q. Left Coy. These people. The reference is roughly (U.S.a.9.5.). Am going up there and going into the affair as thoroughly as possible. Will send you in a sketch and report - for Allied satisfaction.-!!

Could you please send me by return runner one of each of the two new 1/20,000 maps with latest trenches.

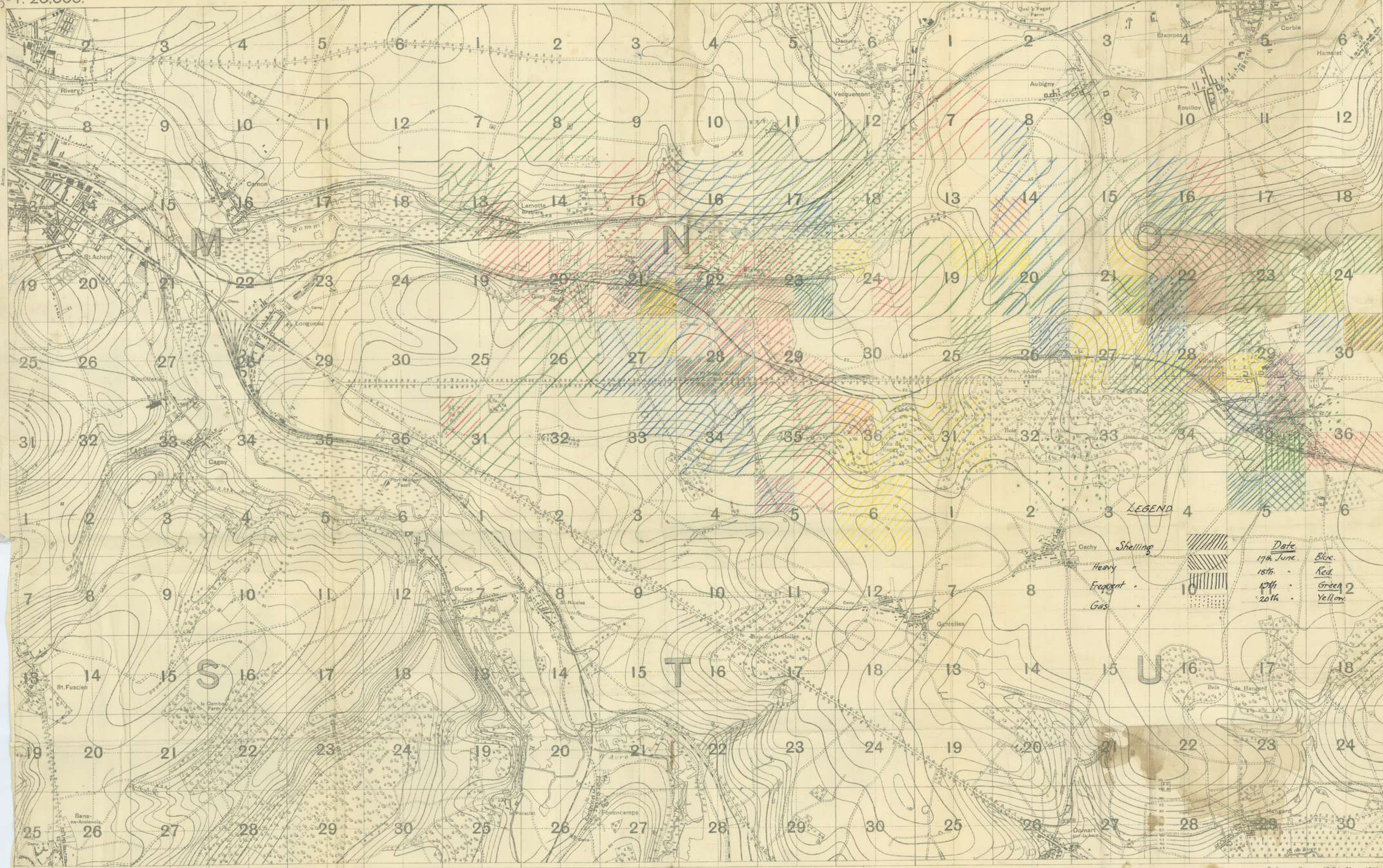


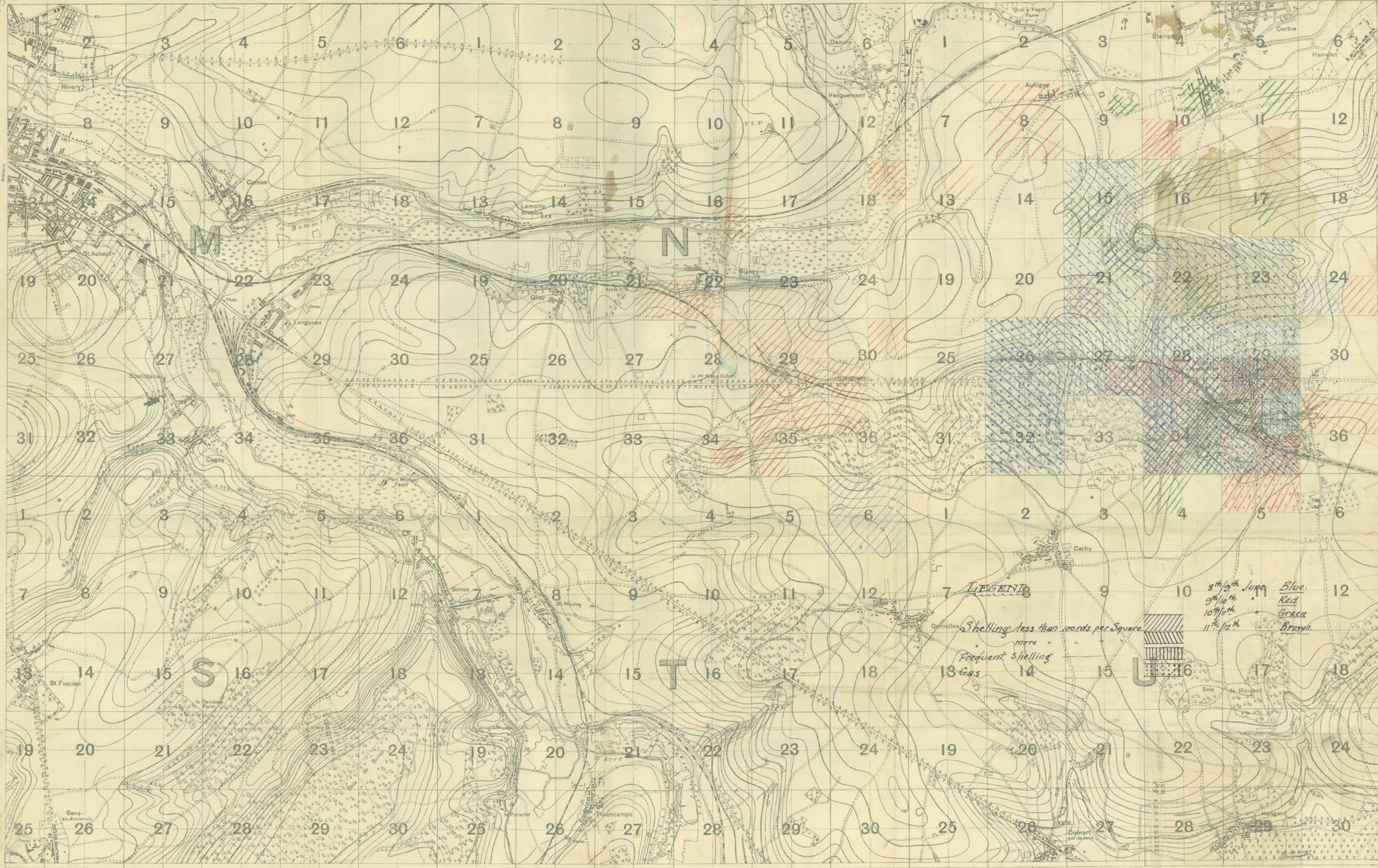
HOSTILE SHELLING MAP
