

ORDER OF MARCH.

The Band and Signalli n q Sec. wil 1 march with "A" Coy. B"B and D Coys. followin at an interval of 200 yards. Companies will march at an interval of setween platoons. First Line Transport will march in rear of the Battalion and will be treated as a Company?

Staring Point Road Junction & mile E of LA CRECHE - STEENEWERCK - Le VERRIER, thence to Billets at BLEU.

TRANSPORT.

4. One Motor Waqon has been allotted the Battalion and may be used for second trip if necessary. Q.M. will detail a quide to meet waqon at NEUVE EQLISE Road Junction (Sheet 28 S W T 15 a 90.35) at 5 a.m. and quide waqon to locat ion required.

CAMP

5. Companies will ensure that their lines are left scrupulous ly clean. Oply Bailey and 6 o/rs wil 1 be detailed from A" Coy. to remain and obtain a certificate from incomin q Unit that the Camp has been left in a clean and sanitary condition, and will hand such certificate in to Bottalion Hors. at PLBU on arrival. This Party will report to Battalon Hors. at 7 a.m. on the 3rd. inst for instructions.

6. An admance billetting party of one officer and 4 N.C.Os. have already proceeded to BLEU to take over Billeta and quides will meet Battalion at Road Junction half Mile E of BLEU

REAR PARTY. 7. A rear party of one Sergeant and8 o/rs.wil libe detailed from "D" Coty. to collect any sick and stragglers who fall out., who must have a chit signed by an officer.

APPENDIX.6 5-8-17 . 3 1146 34th Battalion Move Order 51. The 34th Battalion will move to ALDERSHOT Camp near NEUVE EGLISE on 6th mot: and I NCO to be detailed from each Coy, will report at Batter Hates at 8.0 AM for Transport. 22 Motor Wagons have been requisitioned for to convey Troops and Stores from Billeting area to Camp, and will be allotted to logs and QM; Blankets. Blankets are to be rolled in brusles of 10 and will be carried on motorwayons. Travelling Coys Kitchens will be ready at 8.0 AM. and Transport Set will arrange for 1st Line Transport to pass present Transport Standings at 9.0 AM. and march as a Company direct to ALDERS HOT Phiers Baggage. Officero Baggage will be carried on Motostranspor Headquarters. Headquarters will close at BLEU at 9.0 AM, and reopen at ALDERSHOT. Camp at 11.30 ACKNOWLEDGE.

L. The 34th. Battalion less portion of Transport will move move by train to WIZERNES Area on 15th inst .

The train timings will be notified later. The tr ansport details for which separate instructions have been issued the T.O. will leave AlDERSHOT CAMP 4 hours before the time the Omnibus train departs from BAIBLEUL.
