

packs, Officers kits, and surplus gear will be dumped at at Q.M. store within two hours of receipt of orders to move. Hats will be placed in packs. Packs will be marked in accordance with orders previous issued.

8. All bomb and S.A. cases must be returned to Q.M. Store before unit moves out.
