

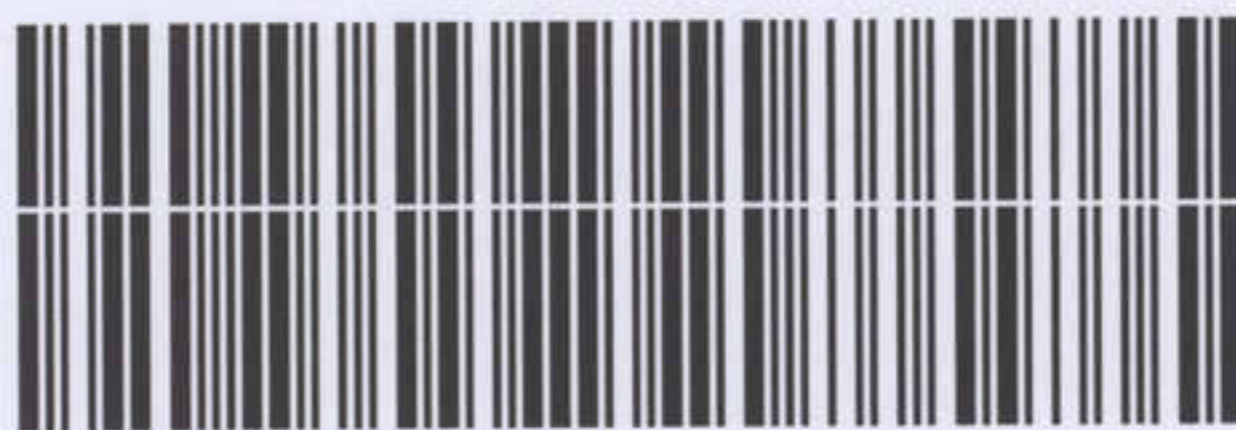

	20-9-17		Workshops completed and camp constructed at Ellarside, and working parties for workshops, construction work on forward lines, and unloading parties supplied until 29 <sup>th</sup> September, when orders received to move camp to Mimico, situated near the junction of Ypres-Poperinghe and Belgian Battery corner road, to take over the working of Mimico District.	
	30-9-17		Removal of camp to Mimico completed, and work of constructing camp taken in hand.
