RIBEMONT.	1-4-18.		<p>3AM Orders issued for 2 reserve sections to stand by with their limbers in case of emergency.</p> <p>Report was received that the enemy was massing outside PERNANCOURT with the object of attacking the 11<sup>th</sup> Division on our left flank. Attack did not eventuate.</p> <p>Orders received that this company would relieve the 10<sup>th</sup> M.G. Coy on the left Brigade front. O.C. in company with Lieut. G.H.F. Meade-Mullen visited company HQ in TREUX and completed arrangements for relief.</p> <p>During the afternoon limbers prepared and gun teams told off. Limbers moved off about 7.15 pm. Relief complete by 11.30 am.</p> <p>Provisioning Kitchen taken over from Battalion. Instructions issued that a hot meal was to be brought up nightly with the ration limbers.</p>

This bombardment increased and decreased till about 9. 30 AM when for the present it ceased.</p> <p>About 8. 45 AM enemy machine gun opened fire from the direction of the river, and appeared to be sweeping over the village. About 9. AM what appeared to be our own Machine &amp; Lewis guns opened fire to our right. With a view to breaking up any concentration the enemy may have made in front of the village, the H. machine guns were ordered to place a show rate of fire barrage on a sunken road in front of MARRETT WOOD SPUR - No definite information as to enemy action is yet to hand.</p>
