

All in good order but the staff affected with influenza. Division appears to be in good working order. Postal orderly of the 5th Aust Pioneer Battalion and 5th Aust Machine Gun Battalion were questioned and stated all Unit mails arriving satisfactory. Card systems of both units up-to-date and information as to men marching in and out secured daily and cards amended daily. Inspected FPO D.W. Hallencourt, office in good order. Daily states not being furnished by 3rd Aust Division Signal Coy. Instructed Div Supervisor to draw attention to this matter. Detective Brennan from A.I.F. Headquarters visited Corps in connection with recent robberies at R.W.1 and R.W.2. Arranged for him to visit Ailly-sur-Somme and Longpre by car tomorrow in company with Lieut Gerrans. Lieut Gerrans in company with Detective Brennan visited 2nd and 4th Aust Divisional Railhead A.P.0s in connection with robbery at former office. Nothing discovered which is likely to lead to a clue as to the offenders.

D.R.T.O. AMIENS was also interviewed with a view to locating the detective detailed for duty at Longpre-les-Corps Saints on the night of the robbery but without success . F.P.O. 4.W was inspected and found to be ina satisfactory condition. Nothing to report. 10th 11.18 10.11.18 11.11.18Corps Headquarters moved from EU to Le Cateau today .. Mails were EU and Le Cateau 11.11.18 available for delivery at EU prior to departure from EU. F.P.O. re-opened at Le Cateau at 6. pm. Express mails received at noon today. 12.11.18 Le Cateau 12.11.18 Visited 2nd and 5th Aust Divisional Artillery Headquarters 13.11.18 at Estrees-en-Chaussee and Athies respectively . Collected their Express Le Cateau 13.11.18 bags from A.P.O. S.76 BUSIGNY en route and delivered them where calling. Arranged for mails to be circulated to S.125 Peronne in future . Inspected F.P.O. T.W.2 and F.P.O. T.W.5 and informed them of new arrangements. A.P.O. S.40 on which the Artilleries were formerly located moved to BOHAIN today , much too far away to allow of collection by F.P.O. G.S. Wagons. Nothing to report. 14.11.18 14.11.18 Le Cateau Attended Conference Fourth Army today . Owing to occupation 15.11.18 of German territory by Allied troops all present mail circulation arrangements 15.11.18 Le Cateau will be considerably revised. Fourth Army Depot office (A.P.O. S.76) BUSIGNY, closes on completion of duty on 16th inst and Australian Corps and Divisions will then work through A.P.O. S. 61 CAMBRAI (Third Army Depot) for Cross Post and Expresses . D. 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Place Date Hour Le Cateau 15.11.18	Summary of Events and Information 15.11.18 continued. Have arranged to work in conjunction with XIII Corps until Australian Corps takes up its position in line on the RHINE, when new arrangements will be made.
Le Cateau 16.11.18	Fourth Army Depot office (A.P.O. S.76) closed today at BUSIGNY. Australian Corps inward and outward despatches will work through Third Army Depot (A.P.O. S.61) Cambral as from and including the morning of 17th inst. Australian Corps lorry left for S.61 tonight and will park there overnight bringing out despatches for Corps in the morning. Lieut Gerrans wisited IX Corps in connection with transfer of Heavy Artillery from that Corps to Australian Corps today. It has been fould necessary to re-open A.P.O. S.W.1 to serve these units and they have benn located accordingly. An additional lorry has been allotted by S.M.T.O. Aust Corps for this purpose. Instructions wired to staff of S.W.1 to proceed with stock and fittings to BUSIGNY pending further instructions.
Le Cateau 17.11.18	Visited BUSIGNY and arranged for the opening of S.W.1 to serve Australian Corps units recently transferred from 1X and X111 Corps. Lorry also allotted by 6th Aust M.T.Coy to this office for mail purposes. Cross post and Expresses worked in conjunction with R.W.1 to S.61 at CAMBRAI.
