

 - 2. During your tour of duty you will not take off your boots or any article of clothing; nor will you permit any of the guard to do so.
 - 3. On taking over from Old Guard you will read these Guard Orders and also Orders for Sentry Posts No. 1 and No. 2 to your Guard and you will make sure that all soldiers of the Guard are well acquainted with same.
 - 4. You will visit sentries at irregular intervals and will make sure that sentries are at their posts and on the alert. Should you find any sentry neglecting his duty you will immediately place him under arrest.
 - In case of fire you will at once send for Sergt. Anderson at 20A Rue Alart opposite Railway and fall in the guard at Fire Assembly Point No. 1, where you will be under orders of the Senior N.C.O. of the Clothing Exchange.

6. You will report at once to Clothing Exchange Office or Sergt. Anderson, any unusual occurrence during your period of duty.
