Corps Clothing Exchange.

1. During your tour of duty you will take orders only from Officer i/c Corps Clothing Exchange or his representative.
2. During your tour of duty you will not take off your boots or any article of clothing; nor will you permit any of the guard to do so.
3. On taking over from Old Guard you will read these Guard Orders and also Orders for Sentry Posts No. 1 and No. 2 to your Guard and you will make sure that all soldiers of the Guard are well acquainted with same.
4. You will visit sentries at irregular intervals and will make sure that sentries are at their posts and on the alert. Should you find any sentry neglecting his duty you will immediately place him under arrest.
5. In case of fire you will at once send for Sergt. Anderson at 20A Rue Alart opposite Railway and fall in the guard at Fire Assembly Point No. 1, where you will be under orders of the Senior N.C.O. of the Clothing Exchange.
6. You will report at once to Clothing Exchange Office or Sergt. Anderson, any unusual occurrence during your period of duty.

Sentry Post No. 1.

1. Beat: From Main Gate through door of Foundry to the far end and back again. ~~WHEN~~ <sup>Where</sup> there are trucks of clothing in the siding the beat will be extended to encircle the trucks.
2. You will march up and down your beat in a brisk and soldierly manner and pay compliments to all officers according to rank.
3. You will guard all government property within view.
4. You will allow no one to remove clothing from trucks or store without authority from Officer i/c Clothing Exchange or his representative.
5. No soldier or civilian is at any time to be allowed to leave building with a parcel likely to contain clothes.
6. You will allow no soldier or civilian without written authority near trucks after dark.
7. You will particularly guard the stack of dirty clothing just inside the door of Foundry.
8. You will at once place under arrest any soldier or civilian whom you suspect of thieving or attempting to thief.
9. In case of fire call out the Guard and assemble it at Fire Assembly Point No. 1. Send a soldier of the Guard at once to waken the senior Sergeant of clothing Exchange at No. 20A Rue de Alart, opposite Railway.
10. Fire Assembly Point No. 1. is near Main Door of Foundry.
11. In case of necessity you will not hesitate to use your arms.

Sentry Post No. 2.

1. Beat: From Main Gate of Foundry along footpath to Men's billet No. 12 Rue de Zone.
2. You will march up and down your beat in a brisk and soldierly manner and pay compliments to all officers according to rank.
3. You will guard all government property within view.
4. You will allow no one to remove clothing without authority from Officer i/c Corps Clothing Exchange.
5. No soldier or civilian is at any time to be allowed to leave building with a parcel likely to contain clothes.
6. You will at once place under arrest any soldier or civilian whom you suspect of thieving or attempting to thief.
7. In case of fire call out the Guard and assemble it at Fire Assembly Point No. 1. Send a soldier of the Guard at once to waken the senior Sergeant of clothing Exchange at No. 20A Rue Alart, opposite Railway.
8. Fire Assembly Point No. 1 is near Main Door of Foundry.
9. In case of necessity you will not hesitate to use your arms.
