No work other than the receiving of material at Branoutre dump

2/1/18

Party at Orvaet despatched 4 trucks of shell cases & boxes to St. Pennebatz and packed shell cases the remainder of day

2 OR at Right Bde dump setting fuses on 1572 shells at safety for transport. 18 OR.

Collecting R.E. material in forward area one lorry load of general salvage despatched from Branoutre dump to Railhead

Bouloze and one load from same dump to St. Pennebatz. Snow still on ground

3/1/18

10 OR collecting R.E. material forward Party collecting Gen. salv around Orvaet.

Two lorry loads of salvage despatched from Branoutre to Bouloze R.H.

Party on dump at Branoutre. Snow still on ground

Party detailed to collect R.E. material daily which is required urgently for defence works. Snow still on ground

Five trucks loaded at Orsact and despatched to Dr. Kennelak. Party collecting RE material forward. Party collecting zero house area. Two lorry loads despatched from Dransoutre dump to Bruloze R.H. Party on Dransoutre dump receiving & packing. Snow thawing. Snow laying on ground has interfered with collecting for the past few days.
