

- Information has been received that the enemy is holding the line BOUCHAVESNES - MOISLAINS as an outpost position, and aeroplanes report that trenches are being hastily dug in C.22 b. and C.23.a.
- The 13th Aust. Inf. Brigade has been ordered to advance due South from SAILLIAEL and seize the high ground in C.22.b. and C.23.a. The 4th Aust. Inf. Brigade operating on the Right and
- The 51st Battalion is forming the Advance Guard for the Brigade and will capture the ridge extending from C. 17. a. 7. 2. to C. 16. b. 4. 4. When this position is EXPUXER captured by the 51st Battalion, the 49th Battalion will pass through and attack the ridge on a frontage extending from C.23.b.2.8. to C.23.a.6.8. The frontage being approximately 700 yards. Compass bearing from the Forming up spot is 184 degrees true bearing.

The attack will be carried out in two waves. -1st. Wave to consist of "A" and "D" Companies in two lines.

The Reserve Company will take up its position in the Sunken Road running through C.16. and C.17.

  - (b) 49th and 51st Lattalions and 15th. M.G.Goy (loss 1 Section) will be formed up along the North Dastern adge of the Wood in 0.10.a. at 10.30 a.m.
    50th lattalien will be at the same place at 11.30 a.m.
  - (c) When the main attack has passed through the Advanced Guard the 53nd Cattalien will be referred and marched back to Camp under the Senior Major other Officers and senior N.C.O's remaining to watch the concluding part of the exercise.
- 2. Transport will not parado.
- The action of Units on the flanks will be taken to be normal unless Cormanders are otherwise infermed.

Major W.M. FOWLER, 50th. Battalion, and the Trigade Intelligence Officer will act as Unpires to prevent unreal situations developing. Ther will wear white armbands. Written "situations" will be given to Officers commanding leading troops and simultaneously to Dattalion Core nders on which the will set, but this does not absolve any Officer from sending on such information as he receives.

- 4. The enemy will be represented by non with flags.
  Flags held still denote that the enemy has superiority of fire. Flags waving that fire power is equal.
  When flags disappear the attacking force has gained fire superherity supremacy.
- 6. Casu Itios will be simulated, but the Field Ambulance will not be represented.
