

Report on Training and Drafts.

P. T. & B. F. The Training in this Branch has continued as per Weekly Programme, and has been up to previous standard. Every soldier has one hour P.T. and one hour B.F. daily.

Anti-Gas was carried out as per Syllabus, and a thorough training in these measures was imparted. 214 Men passed through Gas Chamber during the Month.

Wiring. This Branch of Training has been very thoroughly taught.

Bombing. Standard Tests were carried out, and live bombs both thrown and fired. men passed through Live Bombing Tests during the month.

Officers and Men passed through Lewis Gun Course during the month, including firing with ball ammunition.

Drill. Improvement in drill has continued and the discipline of the Battalion is good.
