



The RED Barrage is to be represented by white signalling flage.
These will be controlled by Lieut. mcIvor, Brigade Intelligence

There will be no BLUE Barrage actually represented by for their counter attack.

The Company Commanders of the two front companies 58th Bn. will act as umpires. 
