CONDENSED REPORT of 2nd AUSTRALIAN DIVISIONAL SALVAGE
COYS' operation during the period under review.

THE COMPANY entered the new Divisional Area on 12th
September 1917 taking over from the 25th Divisional Salvage
Company Dump at JAN GROEBEN H 22 a. 5. 9.

During the period between 12.9.17 and 10.11.17 (the
date of handing over to the 49th Divisional Salvage Coy)
additional Dumps were formed at BRISBANE YALE SIDING
and BIRR X ROADS but it was found that by forming an
extended Dump at the INFANTRY BARRACKS YPRES and
abolishing the Dumps at BRISBANE AND YALE SIDING, that
a greater concentration of effort could be directed for
Salvage, the Dumps at BIRR X ROADS AND INFANTRY BARRACKS
YPRES being handed over in full working order to incoming
Division before leaving the Area;

IT WAS ARRANGED by Corp Head Qrs; that weekly forward
Raids should be carried out by the Salvage Coys conducted
personally by the O.C for the purpose of collecting S A A
and Rifles stacking the S A A in Dumps convenient to and
forward of Brigade Head Qrs; These orders were carried out
with the result that 2000,000 rounds of S A A were handed
over to the Staff Captain at Forward Brigade Head Qrs; that
500 Rifles and 12 Lewis Guns were brought back to the Main
Dump and reissued;

DURING these operations the Company was working more
or less under continuous shell Fire and in the presence of
shell Gas, with the resultant loss of five killed and two
wounded;

WITH REGARD to the Ammunition salvaged it is stated
that 70% of same was fit for reissue and such issue would
have been carried out had means of cleaning so great a
quantity been obtainable. To the Rifles and Bayonets
of the former at least 75%, and of the latter 80% were in
excellent order and fit for issue had they been required;

Many Soldiers returning from the line without equipment
etc were immediately reequipped of which no record was taken;
