It is imperative that there shall be no accumulation of empty ammunition boxes or fired cartridge cases at A.R.Ps; and the following is issued so that there may be no misunderstanding in future.

D.A.Cs are responsible for packing empty cases into boxes, refastening lids, and rendering empties fit for return to Railhead. Where there are insufficient boxes, cartridge cases may be packed in sacks. Boxes and sacks must be fastened so that the contents cannot become Loose in transit.

M.T. Units must accept for return, all empties at A.R.Ps, and are responsible for their removal to railhead. Where lorries are making a last trip; empties may be retained on load, and delivered to railhead the following morning. If necessary they may be temporarily

dumped near Parks.

Officers commanding M.T. Coy and Park Section Groups will ensure that all N.C.O's and Drivers are acquainted with these instructions. It should also be impressed upon all ranks that empties require as careful handling as full boxes- much irreparable damage is at present caused through carelessness in this respect.

Also the disparity between the number of fired S.A.A wax cartridge cases returned by the Divisionand the amount of S.A.A. used is very marked, and in connection with this I would add that I have already sent a circular memo to the Brigades, Machine Gun and Pioneer Battalions, but from results it would appear that the urgency of concentration on this Salvage is not yet appreciated as it should be.

2. Salvage Dumps will be formed at wagon lines and in close prox imity to Divisional Supply and Ammunition Refilling Points. Salvage will be taken to these Dumps by returning transport and from wagon line dumps to Divisional Dumps by transport proceeding to fill. A detachment of the Divisional Salvage Company will be stationed at each Dump near Supply or Ammunition Refilling Points for the purpose of sorting and packing salvaged material.

3. From Divisional Dumps, Salved Ammunition, components, ammunition boxes, fired brass cases, etc., will be taken to FLESSELLES or SALEUX Railhead by returning ammunition lorries and general salvage to Supply Railheads by returning supply lorries or by horse

transport proceeding to Railhead to fill.

4. Area Commandants will establish Salvage Dumps in their own areas for collection of miscellaneous salvage, notifying the location of the dumps to Corps Salvage Officer. When approximate ly a lorry load of salvage has been collected into his dump the Area Commandant will advise the Corps Salvage Officer who will arrange for its removal to the Corps Main Salvage Dump, AILLY-SUR-SOMME.


5. The Corps Salvage section will have a detachment at FLESS-ELLES and SALEUX Railheads and at each Supply Railhead to receive salvage from Divisional Dumps and the Corps Main Dump. These detachments are for the purpose of loading and despatching only, and all salvage sent to Railhead must be sorted and packed ready for despatch to Base. All empty shell cases must be properly boxed or bagged before being returned to Railhead.

6. The Salvage Company of each Division will work in its own Divisional Area and will accompany its Division on reft relief. To ensure continuity of work the Salvage Company of a Division in the forward area will not be withdrawn until relieved by the in-

7. Salved paper, cardboard and jam cartons will be returned to Supply Railheads through the above channels. The Corps Salvage Officer will arrange for its removal from Supply Railheads to the Paper Baling Press at AILLY-SUR-SOMME.

SALVAGE.

The Area at present occupied by the Brigade offers almost unparalled opportunities for Salvage, and it is desired that Units take full advantage of these opportunities to salve all material in their respective areas.

A census of Divisional Salvage figures covering the last four months shows that the Units of the 9th Brigade taken both separately and collectively, have contributed less than any other similar Unit to the Salvage of the 3rd Australian Division.

This state of affairs is obviously very unsatisfactory

and points to one of two things:-

(a). Total lack of interest in this most important work by

Officers and Other Ranks, or,

(b). Neglect on the part of Officers and Battalion Staffs to see that every endeavour is made to salve everything of wat value and to carry out instructions issued from time to time on the subject.

Whatever the reason for lack of Salvage it must be

rectified at once.

Although the Brigade has performed numerous operations successfully which have demonstrated the fighting spirit, it still remains for Units to shew their merit in other fields.

Although it is recognised that the best form of Salvage is economy in the first instance, here again units of this Brigade are much more in the habit of indenting on Ordnance than of attempting to salve the stores required.

It is imperative in the best interests of the Brigade that a our unenviable position be improved and brought in line with other un

units of this Division.

Every Officer and man in the Brigade is looked to to help in this most essential work. The scheme laid down in Administrative Instruction No 33 still holds good . One man from the Divisional Salvage Company is attached to each Battalion to give receipts for Salvage, and to instruct Q.Ms as to disposal . Ration Limbers, A.S.C. Waggons and motor Lorries can and must be utilised to the fullest extent. The following articles are required to be salved in larger quantities than as at present. These articles are urgently required in order to keep; up supplies to the front line troops. In some cases the manufacturers practically have to rely on the material salved in order to supply the ever increasing demands.

3. (a) S.A.A. Chargers, bandoliers, boxes and empty cartridge cases are urgently required at present- practically noth -ing is salved in this line.

Rifles and Equipment- Lewis Guns spare parts and (b)

magazines.

18 pdr cases and live Rounds. (c)

(前) 18 pdr clips and nose caps, protectors, rubber and brass.

(a) Solder from ration tins etc.

Cardboard Cartons which have been issued containing (e) Jam and Butter etc. to be cleaned and returned through supplies separate to paper and cardboard.

Paper and Cardboard- Practically no effort is made in this respect. A large field for this form of Salvage is

at present untouched. e.g. deserted villages, canteens. (g) Fat. Very little is being done by some units in this respect. At least a pound per man per week could be saved without interfering with whis the food value of the rations. Dead horses should be boiled down for fat. This has not yet been tried by this Division.

A return showing the amount salved for the week ending Thursday in each week in each of the abovementioned articles will be forwarded to reach Brigade Headquarters by 10 p.m. every Thursday.
