		12	Dull and overcast. Brigade Route March.	
		13	Fine day. Church Parades.	
		14	Showery all day. Usual training carried out in Training Sheds and Huts. Presentation of Medals at No. 1 Command Depot by G.O.C. Brigade paraded at same. Afternoon wet.	
		15	G.M. C. carried out; 63 men firing. G.S.O.I., A.I.F. Depots, came here in afternoon to endorse B.F. & P.T. Instructors' Aldershot Certificates. Night operations carried out under favourable conditions. Good value. A fine sunny day.	
		16	Fine day. G.M.C. carried on - shooting conditions good - shooting good. Orders received for Lieut. Gatliff, Brigade Musketry Officer, and Lieut. Pumphrey, Bde. Gas Officer, and Capt. Rollason, Adjutant 1st. Training Battalion, to proceed immediately on "1914" furlough to Australia. Lieut. Samson, 4th. Bn., (who has not attended the Lyndhurst School), the most capable Officer available, called up to Brigade Headquarters as Brigade Bombing Officer, and Lt. Bechervaise, 5th. Bn., who has done very well with the 1st. Training Battalion as a Company Commander and who is keen on gas and obtained a 1st. class at Isle of Wight Gas School, called in as Brigade Gas Officer.	
		17	Fine day. Training carried on.	
		18	The position as regards N.C.O. Instructors, which was threatening to become acute, relieved by the arrival of the Staff of two Companies who marched in on loan from the 5th. and 12th. Training Battalions. A M.O. sent to report on the influenza epidemic, which has been serious for the last fortnight, reported at Brigade Headquarters. There has been considerably less sickness since the fine weather set in. The root of the trouble is that there is insufficient accommodation in the camps to effectually isolate, without seriously interfering with training, new arrivals from Australia who are naturally most liable to this epidemic. G.S.O.'s inspection carried out in the afternoon. Men brought up were mainly "C" class men regraded "A" class. A very poor lot; six put back to their sixth week of training; arrangements made for the rest to get more anti-gas training before proceeding Overseas. Those put back to their sixth week seemed disappointed. As the new Brigade Gas Officer is not eligible - under Command Orders -

		18	to put men through Chlorine Gas, arrangements made to get Area Gas Officer down every week to do so. Results of the G.M.C. fired this week show that the preliminary musketry training given to Recruits in their first eight weeks here is fairly efficient. A 30 yds. range has just been completed, and by using it in the 7th. and 8th. weeks of training better results should be achieved, for while the miniature range work helps to put right aiming and position mistakes, it does not give the confidence and handiness with the rifle that work with service ammunition gives. Using this range will necessitate issuing Overseas rifle at the beginning of the 7th. week of training. Instructions issued to try to get men Overseas as soon as possible after the completion of their 10 weeks of training - attached as appendix. Captain McElwee carrying on as Adjutant 1st. Training Battalion in place of Captain Rollason (On 1914 leave). Captain Thirkell, Staff Captain, received warning to proceed Overseas at an early date. When he goes the only Officer fit G.S. who was on this Staff on the 1st. inst. remaining will be Lieut. Hall, and he is due for 1914 leave.	
		19	Brigade Route March - 6 miles - good weather - clean turnout. The general appearance of the men has noticeably improved in the last fortnight.	
		20	Wet day. Church Parades.

SUTTON VENY.	1918. Oct.	24	<p>77 men returned to 9th. Training Battalion, FOVANT, whence they were drafted to the 1st. Training Battalion on 5-10-'18. Reason given for this is direction of G.O.C., authority C.R. A.I.F. 35949 (A) of 20-10-'18.</p> <p>Visit from new G.S.O.I., A.I.F. Depots, and G.S.O.II, Southern Command. Training with reduced numbers carried on. Special courses for surplus Instructors commenced.</p>	
		25	G.M.C. finished; markedly better results than previous few weeks. Commandant went on leave till Monday, 28th.	
		26	Brigade Route March - 6 miles - weather fair.	
		28	Commandant returned from leave. Little doing owing to reduced numbers.	
		29	Visit from G.S.O.I., Tidworth. Discussed whether "change arms" at the slope should be done in three or four movements - no decision. Discussed Pioneer indents for training stores which were based on the Pioneer Tng. Bn.'s new functions and establishments (which is to be published in A.I.F. Orders shortly). G.S.O.I. agreed to push these indents on. In future Pioneer Training Battalion (now called Depot) is to be fed only from General Reinforcements who have completed 10 weeks Infantry training, and will only undertake technical training and a little refresher work in Infantry subjects.	
		30	<p>Commandant and Brigade Major, under instructions from A.I.F. Depots, went to a conference at No. 7 Group, R.A.F., Salisbury. Subject of conference:- Training Infantry in cooperation with aircraft. Attendance at this conference was a waste of time as the only proposal put forward that affected the training of reinforcements had already been agreed to on paper (this Office T.1391 of 11-10-'18). However, the G.S.O.I., A.I.F. Depots, fixed up the details with the R.A.F. This training is to consist of a lecture with magic lantern slides by an A.F.C. Officer, followed, as soon as weather conditions permit, by a procession of all British types of planes flying at various heights over the Camp so that the infantry can be taught to recognise various types of planes.</p> <p>Parade ground had a more healthy appearance today owing to men returning from leave.</p>

SUTTON VENY.		Oct. 31	<p>Training carried on. Weather misty. Influenza epidemic has, during the last week or so, been much less severe than in the first part of this month, and seems to be dying out.</p> <p>Several hundred reinforcements are expected to arrive shortly. In order to cope with them the 5th. and 12th. Training Battalions each lent the 1st. Training Battalion one complete Company Staff. In addition, that portion of the Cadre which was due for relief on the 1st. November will not go Overseas till the 1st. December. This is to make up for the number who are away on "1914" leave. The Cadre position, as far as numbers go, is now satisfactory.</p> <p>Up to the last week of this month it has been customary to detail from men in training butt parties for the range when the G.M.C. is being fired. This has now been altered, and the G.M.C. party finds its own butt party in future. This has two advantages: it does not take men from other training for butt parties, and it reduces the size of the firing Details, which enables the men on the firing point to get more individual instruction. Against this it takes longer to get a party through the G.M.C., and this may become a deciding factor in real winter weather.</p>
