

Depots in U.K. Permission to take range into use given. Substantial rumour that Germany had surrendered through the Camp - Much cheerfulness but no disorder. Night operations, posted from Tuesday, carried out - They involved a trench relief interrupted by a raid. The raiding party got well in. Good instructional value.	
	10th.		Fine day - Training carried on.	
	11th.		Captain GLEESON reported for duty as Brigade Quartermaster vice DARCY. Training carried on instead of the usual route March. Platoons which had lost time in any particular subject during the week received instruction in that subject. Commandant went to London on leave.

			Commandant returned from leave. Lecture by Lieut. CLARKE, A.F.C., on the work of the Australian Flying Corps given to the Brigade. News that an Armistice had commenced received quietly. Marched out Cadre personnel to Parkhouse to train 1st. Division Reinforcements ex S.S. "BARAMBEE" in isolation after severe influenza epidemic.

	13th.	Training in morning - weather fine - In afternoon Brigade inspected at work by Sir Colin MCKENZIE, Inspector General of Infantry Training. No faults in training noted or suggestions for changes made by him.	
	14th.	Holiday to celebrate the armistice 1st. Training Battalion had sports in the afternoon and a concert at night. Well attended. Soldiers (probably from No. 1 Command Depot and O.T. Brigade entirely) who were in Warminster during the afternoon amused themselves by hunting the Military Police out of their Camp and chasing them across country for a couple of miles - No damage done.	
	15th.	Commenced new training arrangements whereby the afternoon is given up to Recreational training Men for G.S.O's inspection a particularly good lot. All arrangements at this end made for getting best value out of a mixed flight of aeroplanes which was to fly over the Camp at different heights. The intention was to tell the men the names of each machine in the flight and the work it was used for and the height - as regards effective small arms fire - at which the machines were flying. The weather was suitable but the machines failed to appear.	
	16th.	Brigade Route march - fine day -

	18th .	Only eight men fired G.M.C. last week - average 97.8 improvement of last month more than maintained. Ordinary training in morning - Recreational training in afternoon. Visit from G.S.O.1 .

28th. (Contd.).		<p>There are 600 reinforcements for the 1st. Division at Fovant 300 at Parkhouse, in isolation and 150 arriving from Australia from Overseas, on 5th. December, 1918. There is room for all these in our present Camps, and application was made a few days ago for the 600 to be sent to us. Letter received to-day saying they would be sent in a few days. Visit from A.Q.M.G. A.I.F. Depots in U.K. No. 1 Command Depot which occupies Camps neighbouring ours has not the accommodation for the "C" class men referred to in War Diary for 26-11-18 - A.Q.M.G. wants us to hand over a Camp to No. 1 Command Depot. He was informed that this could not be done if the reinforcements referred to above are coming to us. At 9.30 p.m. a wire was received directing us to arrange to hand over accommodation for 600 men in No. 2 Camp (Pioneer Training Battalion) to No. 1 Command Depot. Also informed that the 900 men referred to above were not coming to us for the present.</p>							
29th.		<p>Arranged in morning with No. 1 Command Depot to hand over 20 huts in No 2 Camp at 2 p.m. on 30th. In the evening received instructions from Tidworth, to hand over at 9 a.m. instead at 2 p.m. Someone appears to have blundered over this, as this was an urgent matter in order to prepare men for catching a very early boat for Australia. The urgency was not made known to us or the Command Depot, who did not want to take over the Camp till the 1st. A.Q.M.G. said that two boats were lost to the A.I.F. in consequence - This probably an exaggeration. Signal School moved from Pioneer Training Depot to 1st. Training Battalion lines. Trial <del>Test</del> of Captain Strickland, Pioneer Training Battalion concluded - this has lasted 5 days and has caused the absence from their ordinary duties of many Officers required as witnesses.</p>	W.H.						
30th.		<p>Arrangements for handing over huts in No. 2 Camp carried out. G.M.C. fired during week resulted in high standard of previous weeks being maintained.
