

and the Staff Manual respectively. Title pages will be prepared in manuscript. Summary of Events and Information Appendices Hour Date Place List of Maps produced during March attached. No entries for Warch. Battery Positions fixed. (21) Summary of Field Work. Work was commenced with the artillery on March 5th. A net work of points was carried forward as near the line (BUTTE DE WARLENCOURT - LE TRANSLOY) as possible, for use in the event of an advance. Several forward battery positions selected by Battery Commanders were fixed for future reference. A list of prominent fixed points was compiled for the Artillery H.Q. On the 17th., Inst., the enemy retired and in consequence the batteries were for some time in a mobile state. During the advance of our Artillery a system of triangulation by plane-table was carried on as accurately as possible from known back points. Assistance was also given to reconnaissance Officers in selecting prominent points to be used for calibration purposes. Askuchand Luit. No other entries for MARCH.
