This list shows all shortages in the section, but until further information is forthcoming, in connection with our future equipments as a unit - it is not advisable to bring the technical equipments up to strength. Over 75% of equipments on G 1098 represents material used during active operations only, and which at the present time is actually useless. Power Buzzers, listening sets, Coax sets etc at the present time could only be stored; consequently, repairs are being held over until arrangements are made. The same difficulty occurs with Divisions.</p>
