

No. 1 Station. It being decided that this station would be more useful at Kirkuk than at Kifri, on the morning of 16th. a move was made and by easy stages Kirkuk was reached on 19th. Dec.

No. 3 Stn: This station not being now required in the Euphrates Group orders were issued by G.H.Q. for its return to Baghdad. On 19th. December station left Hit and arrived at railhead DHIBBAN on 21st. and entraining on 23rd. arrived at Baghdad, joining Squadron H.Q. on 24th.

Baghdad	Dec.		No. 8. Station: December 1st Station marched from GIL en route to SULRIMANIYAH but guide instead of taking route as mapped out, took what he afterwards explained was a short cut. The mountainous country made travelling very arduous and the horses frequently fell with the instruments, but fortunately no serious damage was sustained. No. 8. arrived SULIEMANIYAH at 1 p.m. on 3rd December and established communication. Owing to difficulty of obtaining rations the horses and transport section left SULIEMANIYAH on 11th December and returned to KIRKE
