



- In accordance with 2nd. Aust. Division Order 227, H.Q. 2nd. Aust. 1. Div. will close at Belloy-sur-Somme 1800 23rd Nov. 1918 and open in FRESHOY area at some hour.
- 22-11-18. Column Lorry No 44 will move off from Belloy to B. Bohain at 8 a.m. in charge of Lieut. Dunbar conveying "A" Relief and H.Q. Section equipment including artificer's shop. This party will carry rations up to 6 p.m. on 24-11-18, and soldiers second blanket on each individual.

This lorry on morning of Bard Inst. will report to Capt. Harrison, N.C. A/ D.A.A.G. End. Aust. Division at H. T.O's office BUSIONY.

- (a) Ligut.
