

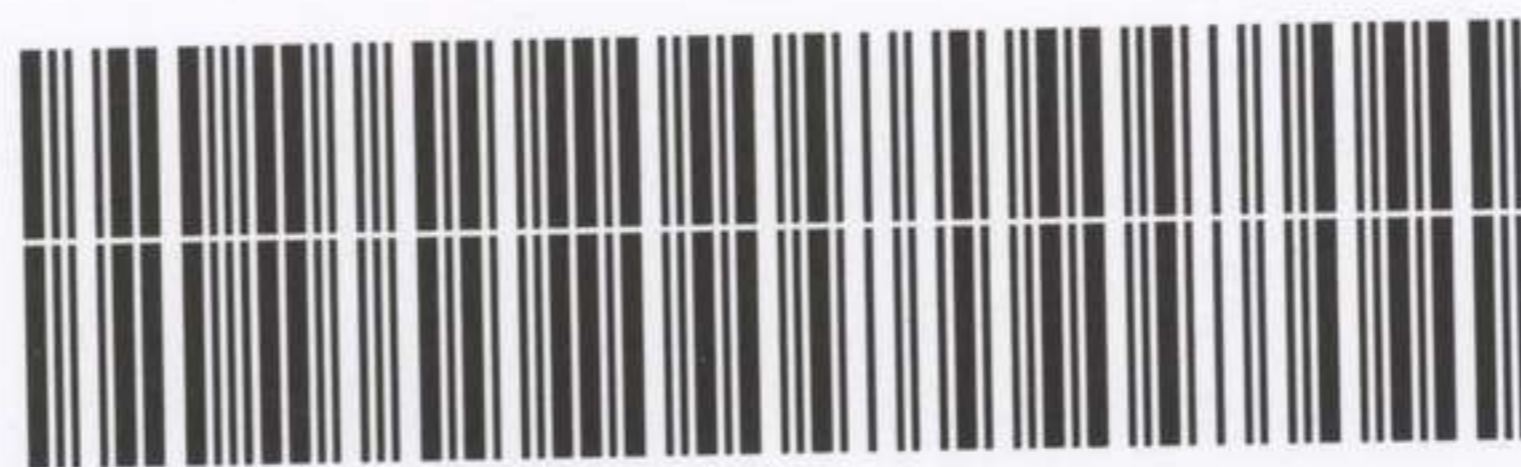

These were localised and repaired. In two cases it was found that the resistance of the SUBS line relay was incorrect necessitating a change of the relay. The whole of the multiple was tested O.K. There were also a number of Telephones, Switches and extension Bells renovated during the month.	
	28th.		2 Horses destroyed by Vet. Surgeon owing to sickness and Carcasses sold to Belgian Butcher for 600 Francs.
