On the 17th. the personnel left again to take over No. 24 station at AMADIA, which place was reached on the 23rd.</p> <p>No. 13 moved out from MOSUL for ZACHO on the 22nd., opening there on the following day.</p> <p>There was no further change at the end of the month.</p> <p>MAY.
