Unit 2nd Signal Squadron A.I.F.

From 1st April 1919 To 30th April 1919

- 1st All telegraph business for stations westward being transmitted through E.S.T. office communications for the Division as follows: Telegraphs to ISMAILIA Signals, 4th and 5th Lt Bdes. Telephones as per attached list of subscribers.
- 2nd Communications as on 1st maintained plus Squadron routine.
- 6th All line in good working order.
- 7th Telephone pair laid to 75th Divisional Artillery
- 8th Communications as on 7th maintained plus Squadron routine.
- 9th Fault repaired on telephone pair No 39.
- 10th Communications as on 9th maintained plus Squadron routine.
- 11th Telephone pairs Nos 10 and 16 faulty; lines overhauled and faults repaired.
- 12th Telephone at No 18 moved to another tent at the 2nd A.S. Hospital. Telephone pair connected to DADOS 75th Division No 38.
- 13th Telegraph traffic for stations westward of MOASCAR now being sent on Military lines, no traffic being sent through Egyptian State Telegraph Office.
- 14th to 20th Communications as on 13th maintained plus Squadron routine.
- 21st Telephone pair No 38 extended to 75th Divisional Trains.
- 22nd to 23rd Communications as on 21st maintained plus Squadron routine.
- 24th Lines to 4th and 5th Lt Bdes faulty at 1900, faults repaired at 1930.

- 25th } Communications as on 24th maintained plus Squadron
 26th } routine
- 27th } Intermittent fault on lines to 4th and 5th LHBdes
 repaired.
- 28th } Faulty telephones on Nos 28 and 35 repaired
- 29th } Communications as on 28th maintained plus
 Squadron routine.
- 30th } Communications as on 29th maintained plus
 Squadron routine. Intermittent fault on
 telegraph instrument on Ismaïlia line, instrument
 changed and line in good working order.

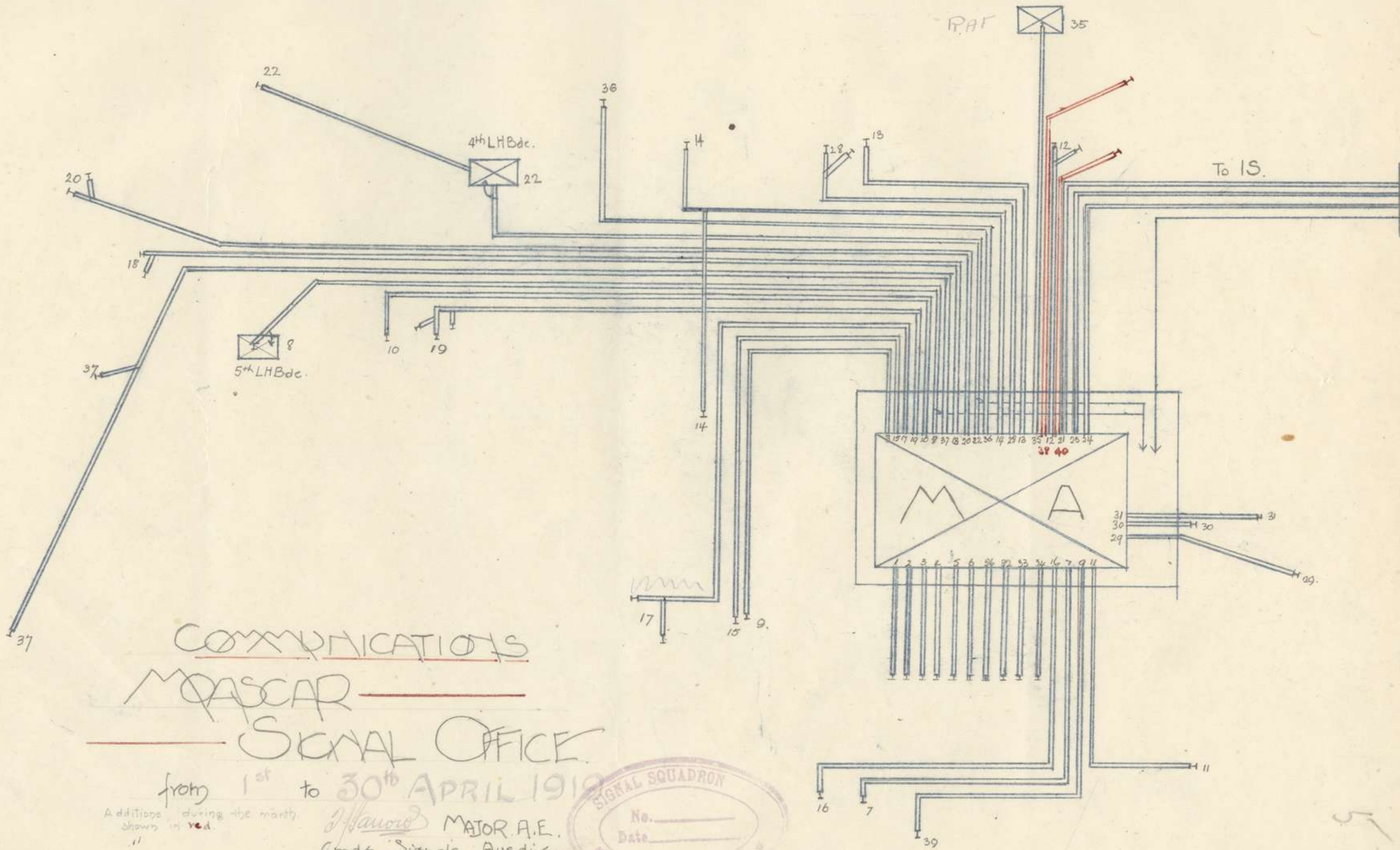

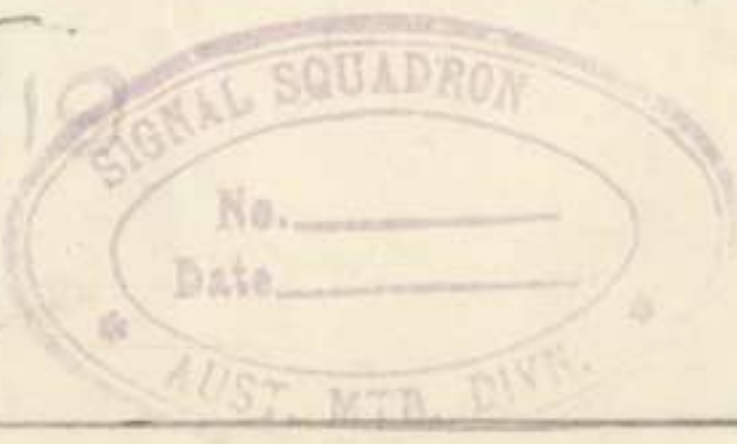
