

WAR DIARY - ATH DIVISION GENERAL STAFF. Hor RENINGHELST. 1ST SEPTEMBER. Situation unchanged. Following relief in accordance with Operation Order No. 55 of 28th August completed. King's Own relieved by 8th Bn. 2nd Australian Brigade, 1st Australian Division in Left Sub-Sector, Right Sector. King's Own moved to POPERINGHE. Operation Order No. 56 issued: -On 4th September 10th Brigade H.Q. and three battalions will move from Camps ST LAWRENCE Area to PROVEN and K.L.M. Camps. 1 Battalion will move to POPERINGHE. Following moves of 12th Brigade will take place on 4th September. Brigade H.Q. and 2nd W.Riding Regt. from Canadian Corps area POPERINGHE to VIII Corps area POPERINGHE. Lancs. Fus. (less 2 Coys) from POPER-INGHE to ELVERDINGHE. 2 Commanies Lancs. Fus. from POPERINGHE to BRAND-HOEK. King's Own (less 2 coys) from POPERINGHE to BRANDHOEK. 2 Coys. King's Own from POPERINGHE to 'L' Works. Essex Regt. from POPERINGHE to P. Camp. RENINGHELST. 2ND SEPTEMBER. Situation unchanged. Command of line from YPRE - COMINES Canal to TRENCH 55 inclusive passed to G.O.C. 1st Australian Division in accordance with Operation Order No.555 of 28th August.
