About the eleventh of April I landed at Hermes and saw Capt Downing, who was then in charge of No 1 and 2 Troops. I took over No 2 detachment and with Lieut. Commandr. Somerville R.N. altered the old fixed spark sets to suit the work that would be required of them on landing. The sets did not work satisfactorily and he replaced them by new ones, fitted with a synchronous spark gap, the old sets (the technical parts only were changed) being taken by the Navy to replace the new ones.

PLAN OF EXTERNAL AND INTERNAL CONNECTIONS

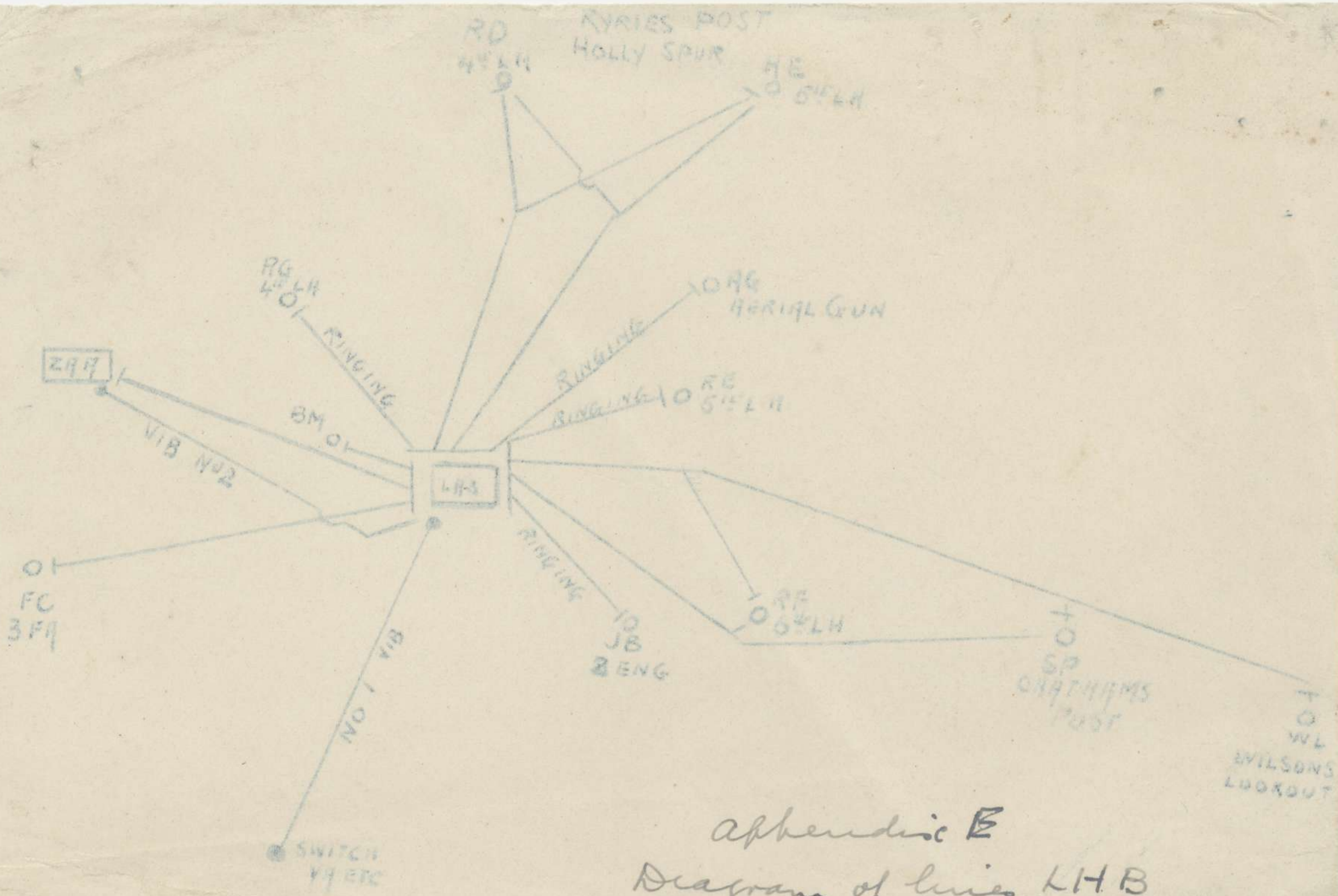

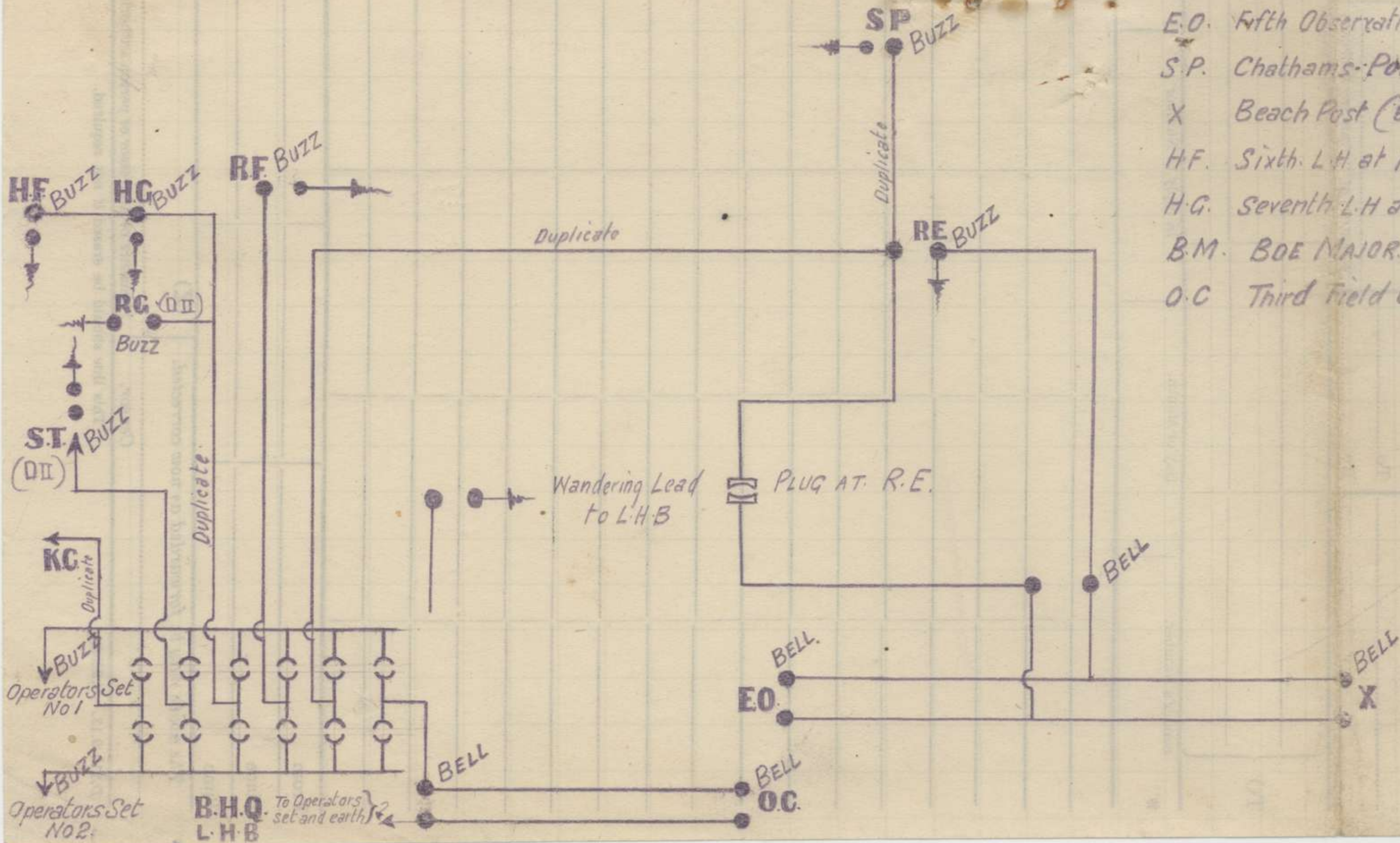
