	2/11/18.		On the return of A.D.A.S. A.I.F. in EGYPT to MOASCAR, O.C. Signal Training Unit, relinquished charge of that office.	
	4/11/18.		The Unit attended a lecture on "Venereal Disease" held at the Camp Cinema.	
	7/11/18.		An RH plane crashed into one of the units shelter structures, and demolished same, no one was injured.	
	8/11/18.		The following Camp routine came into effect:-Reveille 0530, 1st Parade 0615, other hours as heretofore.	
	9/11/18.		Lieut L. Scorer took over command of the unit during the absence of Capt.K.Morice on duty. 1st party of 1914 Furlough men marched in from Anzac Training Regt.	
	11/11/18.		A Wireless message was received at 1400, stating that the Germans had accepted Allies Armistice Terms, commencing at 1100. Capt.K.Morice returned from duty and resumed command of the unit.	
	12/11/18.		Circ. Memo No.12/748, reference "Continuance of regular training" from the Camp Commandant was read to a special parade of all officers and N.C.O's.	
	14/11/18.		The 1914 furlough men marched out for embarkation to Australia per S.S. Port Darwin.	
	15/11/18.		Circ.Memo 61 from Commandant Canal Zone was read on parade to all ranks.	
	17/11/18.		The unit attended a service of thanksgiving for the cessation of hostilities.	
	18/11/18.		Circ.Memo LCA/128/9 from H Q Palestine Lof C, was read on parade for the information of all ranks.	
	24/11/18.		The Commander in Chief, E.E.F., passed through MOASCAR at 0951 enroute for CAIRO. The Unit paraded at MOASCAR Station at 0920.
