

MOASCAR	MARCH	2nd.	In view of a Signal Office for the Australian Mounted Division having to be estabilished in this Camp; personnel was selected, and with-drawn from men under-going an Educational Course, at Central Training Depot.	
"	11	4th.	Men who had been awarded decorations for services in the War, paraded at Camp Headquarters, in order to be photographed by A.I.F. Official Photographer.	
ii .	ti	5th.	A line construction party commenced building a six pair extension route, from Moascar Signal Station, to the site selected for Australian Divisional Signal Station.	
- 11	n ·	7th.	An advance party of 2nd Signal Sqdn, consisting of 14 Other Ranks, marched into this Unit.	
.11	11_	9th.	All men belonging to 4th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th Australian Light Horse Regiments; and 3rd and 4th A.M.G.Squadrons, were marched out to rejoin their Units.	
11	0	10th.	All men belonging to 3rd Signal Troop, were marched out to their Unit.	
п	11	llth.	Six officers marched in from Imperial Cadet School, Zeitoun.	
11	11	14th.	Ten other ranks salected for early repatriation to Australia, were marched out to "A" Details	
11	48	15th.	Signal Training Unit was struck off strength from Australian Training Depot, to Headquarters Australian Mounted Division.	
11	11	16th.	2nd Signal Squadron was accomodated on this Unit's Camp Site.	
5 77 4	LAN OF	18 th.	All men other than those retained as personnels for Moascar Signal Station, were marched out to rejoin their Units; thus leaving a personnel of 2pfficers and 50 other ranks, to carry on Unit duties.  Following parade hours were instituted:- First Parade 0630, - 2nd Parade 0830.	
Wi		19th.	All D.R.L.S. Moascar Signal Station were carried by Royal Air Force.
