1. The 1st. Australian Division will be relieved by 4th. Australian Division in the left Sector of the Corps Front between 8th. and 9th. instant.
2. The 3rd. Aust. Inf. Bde. will be relieved by 13th. Aust. Inf. Bde. and will move and concentrate in "Z" Area in accordance with attached table.
3. (a) All troops moving on roads east of BRICOURT will move in file.  
(b) The following intervals will be maintained :-  

200	yards	between	Battalions.

- (c) Troops moving forward from "R" Area will march via MEAULTE - F.7.C.8.3. - Cross Roads F.1.D.0.0. and will be clear of point F.7.C.8.3. by 1130 a.m.
4. The 3rd. A.L.T. Battery will be relieved on evening of 8th. instant. Mortars will be handed over to relieving Units and receipts obtained.  
The mortars of relieving Unit will be handed over in concentration area.

6. All trench stores, maps, aerial photographs, defence schemes, secret documents etc. will be handed over and receipts obtained.

3. The Brigade, less 10th. Battalion, 3rd. S.G. Coy. and 3rd. T.M. Bty. will march in file to new location on the 28th. January, as per table attached and will take over sites occupied by Units of 150th. Brigade.
4. The S.G. Coy. and T.M. Battery will remain at MILLENOUERT until further orders.  
The 10th. Battalion will remain as situated at ALBERT and FRIGOUERT until further orders.
5. Order of march - Bde. Headquarters, 11th. Battalion, 9th. and 12th. Battalion.
6. Starting Point - point of road opposite Jump "J"
7. Route - via COSTALMAIS a thence east to new location.
8. Time for head to pass starting point - 1000.
9. Intervals to be maintained on the march -  
100 yards between platoons and between every six (6) vehicles.  
200 " " battalions.
10. Advance parties of 2 officers and 4 N.C.O.'s. per battalion will report 24 hours in advance to take over new areas.  
Similar parties will remain behind to hand over camps to Units of 150th. Brigade.  
The Staff Captain, will proceed in advance to take over from 150th. Brigade Headquarters at SAUOT COPSE.  
Advance parties will arrange for guides to meet incoming units at S. 14. B. 7. C.
11. No Government property forming part of camp equipment of camps now occupied will be removed.
12. Separate administrative instructions will be issued later.
13. Brigade Headquarters will close at FRIGOUERT BARN at 1000 on 26th. January and reopen at same hour at SAUOT COPSE.
