

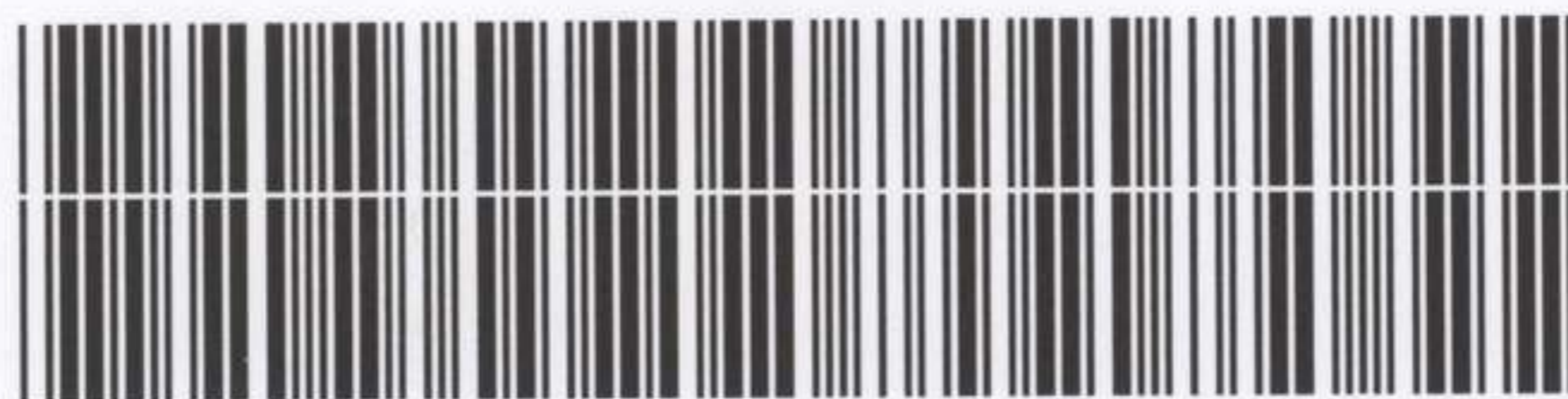

The final scores were 3rd Division 6 Goals 8 Behinds 5th Division 6 Goals 4 Behinds.</p> <p>A Military Funeral was today accorded the late Lieut. A.DAVIS of the 57th Battalion at MAUBEUGE. This Officer died as a result of Influenza. The 57th Battalion Band was in attendance together with a large proportion of the Officers of the Battalion. This Influenza Epidemic is very mild throughout the Brigade Area at present but as a precautionary measure Public Gatherings of troops in buildings have been prohibited.</p> <p>The 15th Field Company A.E. moved on the 27th February to the new area. They have arranged however for the Instructors of the Brigade Technical Classes to remain behind in order that the work of the classes may not be interrupted. Education Report attached.</p>	App. 1.
	2nd		<p>The Divisional Commander Major General E.TIVEY, called this morning and discussed questions of Demobilisation with the Brigadier. He stated that it was probable that Captain LAY, Staff Captain, would be required for work in England at Headquarters A.I.F. This has been rather upset by the delay in Demobilisation with the result that dissatisfaction has now crept in amongst the bandsmen many of whom are overdue for Demobilisation. The General also referred to matters affecting Demobilisation and gave intimation of the early departure of Embarkation Quota No. 20.</p> <p>A conference was held this afternoon at Divisional Headquarters. 



WEEKLY EDUCATION REPORT.

Herewith Weekly Education Report for the Week ending 1/3/19:---

1. Arrangements were made early in the week for a party of 30 Officers from the Brigade to visit the Australian Corps Workshops at Jeumont. These Officers spent a day going through the Workshops and had a most instructive time. They were shown the classes at work and had explained to them the initial difficulties which were encountered in the formation of the workshops. These Officers lectured on what they had seen to their men the following day. It is hoped to thus stimulate interest in the men and let them know the scope of the facilities for training which are offered them.
2. A very profitable series of lectures have been started throughout the Brigade. Lieut. Seward, 59th Battalion, has lectured to Companies in all Battalions on the subject---"Australia, and what it offers to Returned Soldiers". This is but the first of a series of lectures on Australia which will be delivered by Lieut. Seward. The lecturer has travelled extensively throughout Australia and is in every way fitted to lecture on this subject. The attendance has been large.
3. Unfortunately, owing to the influenza restrictions which prohibit men gathering together inside, the lectures on all subjects have had to be temporarily postponed, in conformity with orders.
4. There have been a number of new enrolments in the various classes mainly from the recent reinforcements. The numerous applications forwarded for non-military employment are now beginning to bear fruit, notification having been received for a small batch of men to accompany the next draft to England for placing with firms there. This is very welcome as many of the men were becoming impatient and were beginning to lose faith in ever hearing of any result of their application.
5. The Brigade Technical Classes have been going well but have temporarily suspended for the time being owing to the move of the 15th Field Co. A.E. to the new area.

DEMobilIZATION OF ANIMALS.

REFERENCE NUMBER SHEET 1/100,000.

1. A consignment of "Y" Class horses will be despatched from CHARLEBOI to the Base on 6th inst.
2. This Brigade will send a total number of 50 "Y" class horses. Of this number Units will supply numbers as shown hereunder:-

3. Animals will be inspected by Veterinary Officer prior to leaving Units for entraining station, to ensure that they are sound, and free from contagious disease, eye troubles, etc. The officer i/c party will have a certificate to this effect in his possession for whole Brigade Quota.
4. Hay-nets, nosebags, horse-rugs, head collars and neck chains at rate of one per horse, and water buckets at the rate of one per four horses will be taken to Base.  
Hay-nets, nosebags and horse-rugs will be handed over with the animals at Base Remount Depot, and receipts will be obtained. All other equipment will be brought back to Units.
5. Conducting parties will be supplied as under:-

7. Personnel and horses proceeding will carry unexpired portion plus 24 hours rations. The conducting party will carry full equipment.
8. Rope for Breast lines will be drawn from G.R.E. 5th Australian Division at the rate of one yard per horse.  
Officer i/c Brigade Party will be issued with instructions re this matter on application to this Office.
9. The move from billeting area to CHARLEBOI will be carried out in accordance with Table "A" attached.



1. As a measure rendered necessary by the process of Demobilisation the following reductions have been approved:
- (i) 59th Battalion to amalgamate with the 57th/58th Battalion immediately after the departure of Embarkation Quota No. 20 from the Brigade Group.
  - (ii) On a date subsequent to the departure of Embarkation Quota No. 20 the 8th and 15th Australian Infantry Brigade Groups are to amalgamate. The 15th Australian Infantry Brigade Headquarters will then cease to operate.
2. Regarding (i):

ADMINISTRATION.

1162. FIRE PRECAUTIONS.

The attention of all concerned is drawn to the necessity for continued vigilance with regard to Fire Precautions.

The following points are brought to notice with a view to improving the fire precautions already taken.

- (a) In most of the larger towns the Belgian Fire Brigade are being re-organized, and where this is so, arrangements will be made and posted up in every Unit defining the quickest method of calling on these Brigades for assistance.
- (b) Owing to climatic conditions a considerable number of Fire Appliances are either entirely frozen up or partly so. To obviate the continual changing of water, boxes should be provided or trenches dug, as receptacles for the fire buckets or extinguishers. These receptacles should be built about twice the size actually required, and the appliances, after installation therein, should be packed with straw, manure, or shavings. A light wooden cover upholstered with similar material will ensure that appliances are protected from freezing solid, but an occasional examination is required for the purpose of removing any thin ice which may have formed.
- (c) Stores should be stacked in such a manner that a fire would not destroy the whole of any particular store. Shortage of floor space may not permit of as much space as is desired, but even a few feet spacing, if done judiciously, is to the advantage of fire fighters.
- (d) Fire extinguishers will invariably be charged before being installed.
- (e) Steps will be taken to ensure that heat and smoke from stove pipes are not discharged against woodwork or other inflammable material.

1163. BOUNDS

From midnight 2/3rd March CHARLEROI is placed out of bounds to all ranks of the Corps except those on duty who will be provided with special duty passes stamped by the A.P.M. Corps. or D.A.P.M. Division.

1164. EQUIPMENT ETC.

Units will forward to Brigade Headquarters two copies of all orders issued by them in regard to return of equipment, vehicles etc., to Ordnance Railroad.

1165. LEAVE.

The following wire received from Australian Corps is published for information and necessary action:-

"In future following will not be taken by men proceeding on leave to United Kingdom and local storage must be arranged. Rifles, Bayonets and frogs, box respirators, steel helmets, entrenching tool.

1166. RETURNS.

The return submitted by Battalions and L.T.M. Batteries showing the registered numbers of Lewis Guns and French Mortars in possession is now no longer required.
