

### 4th AUSTRALIAN PIONEER BATTALION.

Commanding Officers appreciation for Month of March 1919.

The area of WEILLEN, ONHAYE, GERIN and SOMMIERE were cleared of all Salvage early in the month.

Owing to inclement weather, sports of any kind were practically impossible.

The usual dance was held twice a week in the Y.M.C.A. WEILIEN, and a farewell Social and Dance on the 19th of March.

on arrival the Two (2) Companies amalgamated under the Command of Capt. W.J. McCALLION. M.C.

The billets in BIESME are very good, and the majority of the men being able to obtain beds.

9 Officers and 44. Other Ranks left the Battalion at the end of the month for AUSTRALIA.

### 4th AUSTRALIAN PIONEER BATTALION.

Transport Officers report for Month Ending 31st March 1919.

During the month the demand for Transport has increased owing to a further shortage of animals.

In addition to the usual requirement of Transport, the Battalion moved from WEILLEN to BIESME, a distance of  $24\frac{1}{2}$  kilometres.

The Battalion being short of animals, 20 mules were horrowed from 4th D.A.C. which enabled us to move the Battalion in two trips.

During the month 28 animals in all were despatched from the Battalion, of which 9 draughts, and 1. ride were sold at a sale in DINANT.

on 24.3.19 four horses were despatched to Base, Le HAVRE.

On the same date four mules were evacuated to M.V.S.

on 31.3.19 five draught horses were handed over to 4th Div. Train, five mules to 1st Div. Train, and two rides were sold at a sale in GERPINNES.
