

ERQUINGHEM	25/6/16	8-15 AM	Company moved ^{out} with all transport for NEUVE EGLISE to report to S.O.C.E. 1st A.N.Z.A.C.	
ALDERSHOT. HUTS	25/6/16	11 AM	Reported in at 11 AM. C.R.E. also S.O.C.E. notified that the move was completed.	
BOIS GRENIER	26/6/16		5th Brigade raid (two sappers detailed with the assaulting party). Raid a success. Two bomb stores blown up.	
NEUVE EGLISE	27/6/16	11 AM	Major Bowley S.O.C.E. handed over O.P.s. these were started and had to be completed.	Bad design
