

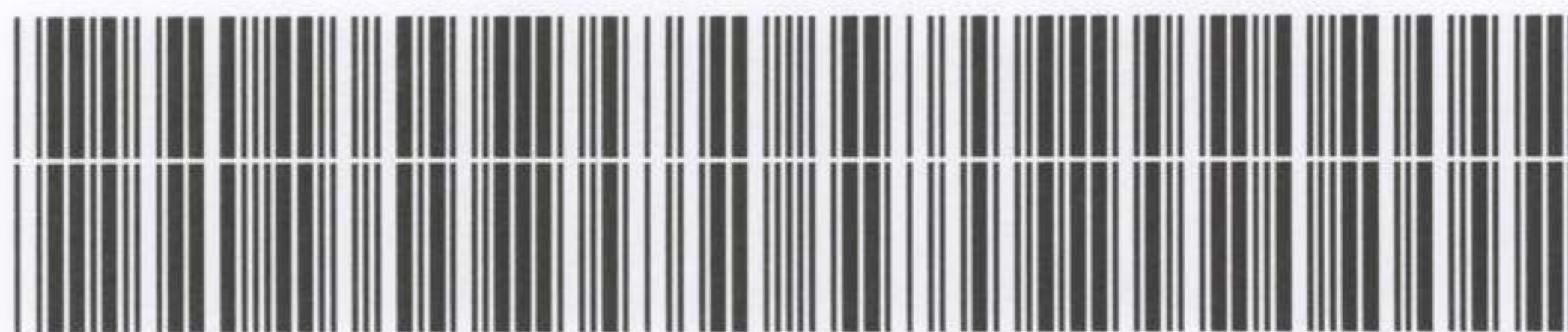

DETRAINMENT OF 9th DIVISION.

1. On detrainment of <sup>the</sup> portion moving by rail at ABEELE Railway Station personnel will be conveyed by lorry, and transport will move by road to DE ZON - LA CLYTTÉ - KEMMEL and RIDGEWOOD Areas where they will be quartered in accordance with Table "A".

Detrainment of 21st Division

1. On detrainment personnel will be conveyed by lorry and transport will move by road to DRANOUTRE, LOCRE, BEAVER, and KEMMEL Areas and be quartered there in accordance with Table "A".
2. 50 lorries under an A.S.C. officer will report to the Detraining Officer at each of the Detraining stations, HOPOUTRE and PESELHOEK. He will detail from these the number required to clear each train and despatch them under a guide: when personnel has debussed lorries will return to the Railway Station.  
Routes and debussing point for lorries are given in Table "B".
3. Transport will proceed from detraining stations to the various camps in charge of guides.
4. One officer and fifteen other Ranks of Corps Cyclist Battalion will be detailed to the detraining officer at each station for duty as guides.

ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS No. 181.

1. As soon as a location for the Corps Reinforcement Camp has been allotted in the new area, the Staff of the Corps Reinforcement Depot under Major RAMSAY will proceed there and establish a new camp for reception of all reinforcements.
2. Reinforcements for 3rd, 4th, and 5th Aust. Divisions will be drafted down to join the Corps Depot as train accommodation becomes available.
3. Reinforcements and Details belonging to 1st and 2nd Aust. Divs. will accompany their Divisions.
4. The Headquarters, Corps Reinforcement Camps under command of Lt-Col. CLAYTON will remain in command of reinforcements and details left behind by Corps. These will, on relief, join the Corps Reinforcement Camp.
5. Orders for the move of the Corps Reinforcement Camp will be issued later.
6. Table "A" shows detachments to be collected before the move of the Corps Reinforcement Camp H.Q.

PROVISIONAL.

1. ORGANISATION OF AREA.

Boundaries of 'A', 'B' and 'C' Divisional Areas are shown in blue on the attached Provisional map. Final boundaries have not yet been laid down by Fourth Army.

2. TRAFFIC CONTROL.

'A', 'B' and 'C' Divisions will be responsible for providing adequate traffic control posts and police protection within their Areas.

3. STRAGGLER POSTS.

A, B & C Divisions will maintain a line of Straggler Posts along the line LA NEUVILLE I.33.b.2.2. - I.23.d.7.5. - J.7.d.8.7. - D.27.b.4.0. - BRESLE D.9.d.3.0. - MILLENCOURT. A.P.M. of Corps will be responsible for the maintenance of the line of Straggler Posts along the HALLUE VALLEY and the Straggler collecting station at PONT NOYELLES.

4. PRISONERS OF WAR.

Divisions will collect prisoners of war at BAIZEUX, HEILLY and a site to be selected by 'A' Division near BUSSY and evacuate them to the Corps Cage at MONTIGNY.

5. TRAFFIC REGULATIONS.

Motor traffic routes are shown in red on the attached map. Headlights will not be used on cars or lorries in the Corps Area E. of St. POL - AMIENS Road inclusive.

Motor cycles may use headlights, but will cover them when halted.

Cars and lorries when halted will cover or extinguish sidelights except sufficient to mark convoys.

6. BURIALS.

Burials will take place under Divisional arrangements as far as possible in sites selected for acquisition and preservation later as military cemeteries.

7. CORBIE.

CORBIE is out of bounds to all officers and men not on duty. It is in charge of a Commandant, Major AIREY M.C., A.S.C.

8. REINFORCEMENTS.

Reinforcements, returning leave men, etc. detrain at CANAPLES where there is a Corps Reinforcement Railhead Officer and staff who despatches reinforcements to CANDAS where a Corps Reinforcement Camp is established and leave men to FLESELLES, where there is a Corps Staging Camp.

From FLESELLES leave men proceed to Divisional Depots as follows :-

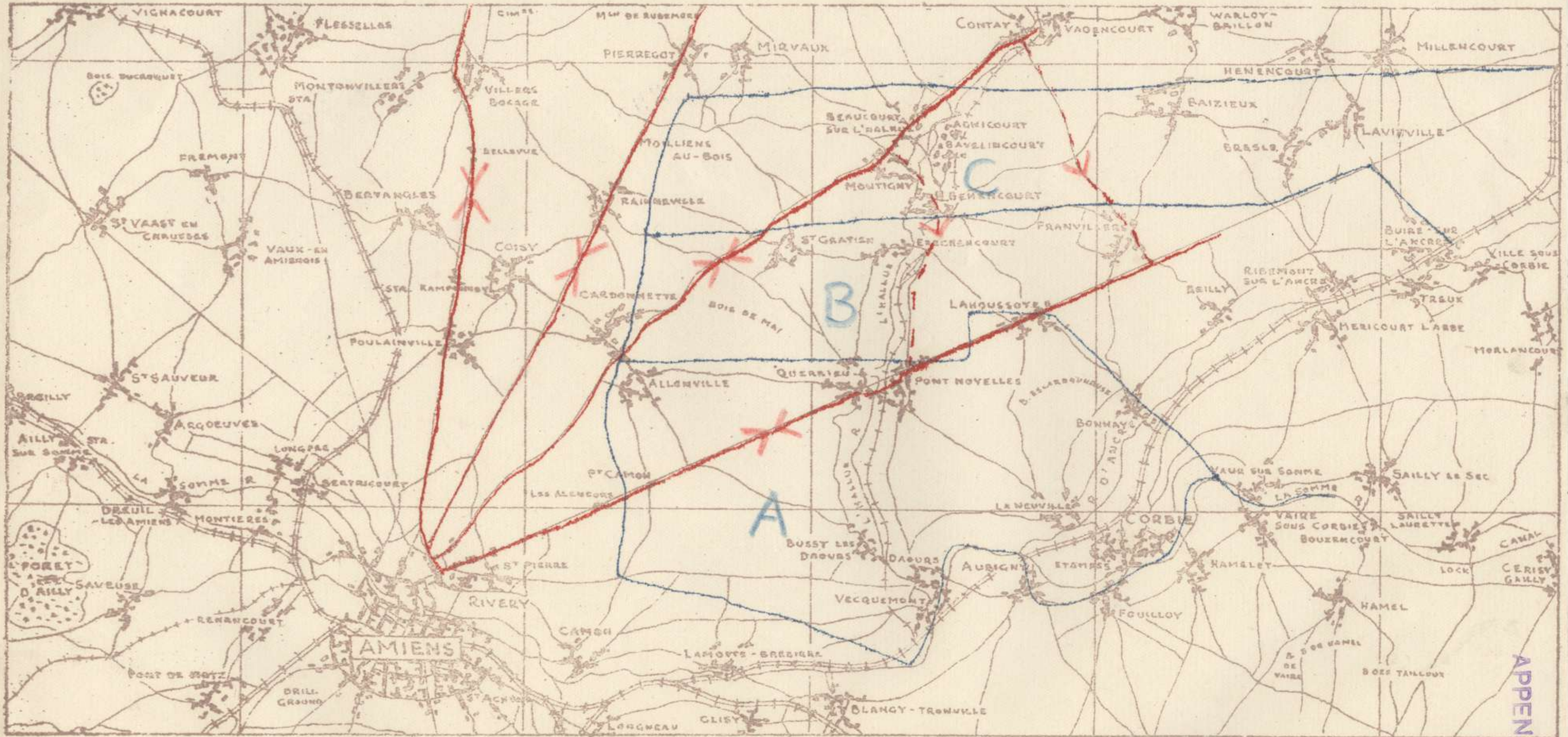



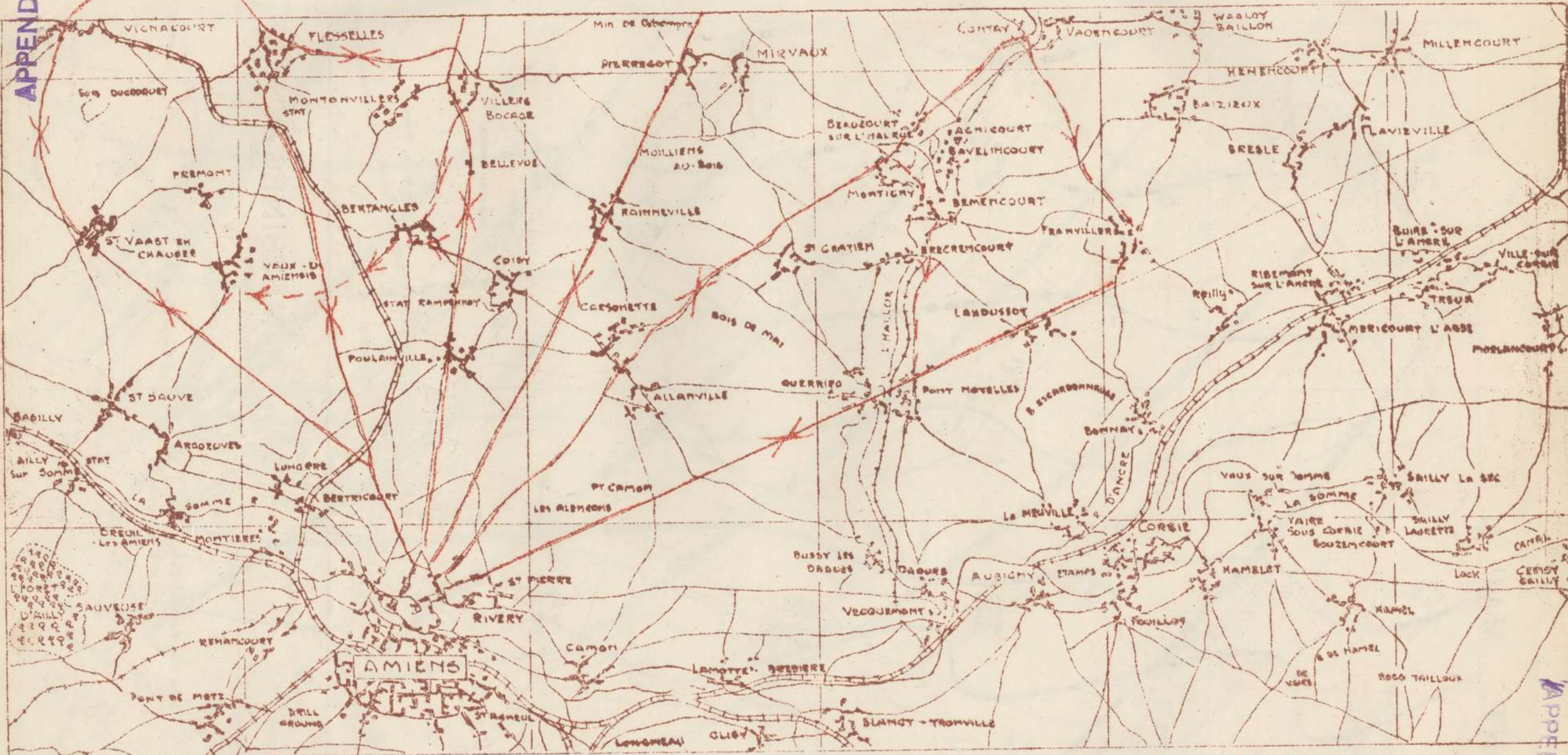

1. Collection of Salvage in the Corps Area under present conditions will be carried out by means of returning transport.
2. Horse transport returning empty to Divisional Supply and Ammunition Refilling Points will be available for transport of salvage to dumps to be formed under Divisional arrangements in close proximity to the Supply and Ammunition Refilling Points. A section of the Divisional Salvage Company will be stationed at each dump to sort and pack salvaged material.
3. From Divisional Dumps, salvaged Ammunition components, Ammunition boxes, fired brass cases, etc., will be taken to FLESSELLES Railhead by returning ammunition lorries, and general salvage to Supply Railheads by returning supply lorries.
4. The Corps Salvage Section will have a detachment at FLESSELLES Railhead and at each Supply Railhead to receive salvage and arrange for its disposal.
5. The Salvage Company of each Division will work in its own Divisional Area and will accompany its Division on relief.  
The location of the Divisional Salvage Officer will be notified to the Corps Salvage Officer and to Corps "Q".
6. The Divisional Salvage Company in the Corps Reserve Area will have at its disposal daily three G.S. Wagons or 4 limbered G.S. Wagons to be detailed by Corps "Q".  
This Company will be responsible for the systematic clearing of salvage from all villages and camps in the Corps Area Reserve Area.
7. Salvaged paper, cardboard and jam cartons will be returned to Supply Railheads through the above channels.

Table "A" herewith contains a list of all the subdivisions of the Divisional Areas and the Corps areas, and the names of the Area Commandants.

"A", "B" and "C" Divisional Areas will be administered in all respects by the Divisions in occupation of them.

ALLOUVILLE and CARDONETTE will be administered by the Support Division.

Staging Areas and Corps Reserve Area will be administered by Corps Headquarters.

2. TRAFFIC CONTROL

"A", "B" and "C" Divisions will be responsible for traffic control in their areas.

Support Division will be responsible for the traffic control of ALLOUVILLE and CARDONETTE, the RUE DE LA - AMIENS ROAD, and Staging Areas "A" and "B".

3. POLICE

"A", "B" and "C" Divisions will be responsible for policing their Areas.

1. AREA ORGANIZATION.

From the date 47th Division takes over "C" Divisional Area MOLLIENS-au-BOIS will become a Corps Area and will be taken over by Captain HARRISON, Area Commandant, PIERREGOT-MIRVAUX.

(Administrative Instructions No. 192 para. 1 and Table "A" will be amended accordingly).

2. TRAFFIC CONTROL.-POLICE AND STRAGGLER POSTS for "C" Divisional Area (including MIRVAUX and MOLLIENS-au-BOIS) will be taken over by 47th Division at 10 a.m. on 2-5-18.

From 10 a.m. on 2-5-18, 2nd Aust. Division will take over the responsibility for Traffic Control and Police in the CAMON-RIVERY-LONGPREL Areas and the Area between AMIENS-RUBEMPRE and AMIENS-DOULLENS Roads both inclusive.

3. REINFORCEMENTS.

Drafts coming forward to join Units will be despatched to the Corps Reinforcement Depot at PERNOIS, from whence they will proceed by route march to the Units Transport Lines, staging the night at the Corps Reinforcement Staging Depot, VILLERS BOGAGE. 47th Division will not have a Staging Depot at MOLLIENS: Administrative Instructions No. 192, para 8 will be amended by deleting under Divisional Reinforcement Depots "C Division MOLLIENS-au-BOIS."
