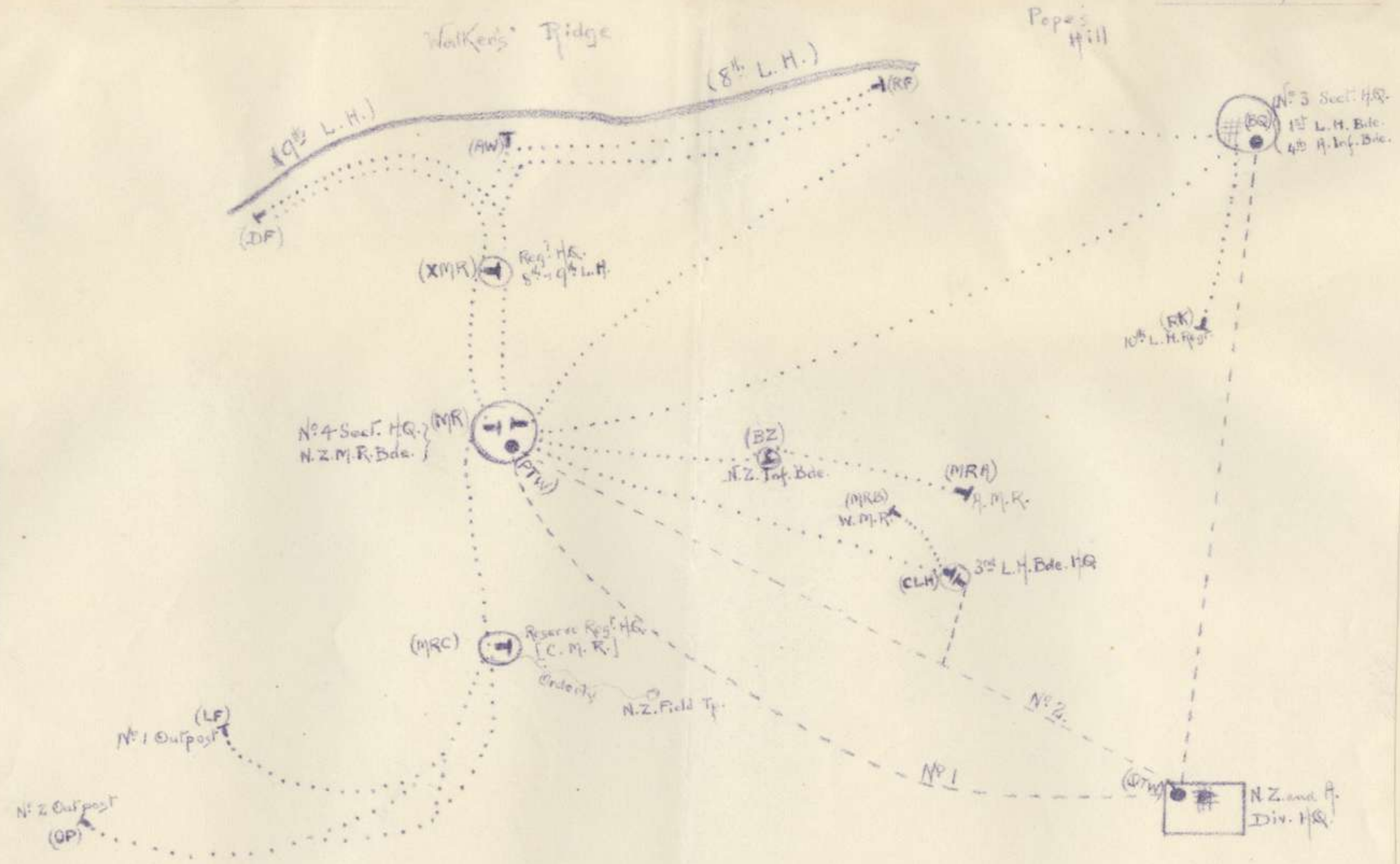


No. 4 Section. SYSTEM OF COMMUNICATIONS.
