

WAR DIARY - DECEMBER 1918.

During them month the weather has been very unfavorable for all training, but every opportunity was taken to encourage Recreational Training. Several competitions took place in the Brigade; Football, Tug of War etc., the men attending these well.

On the 15th., the Battalion moved by Route March from SOLRE-le-CHATEAU to VILLERS POTERIE, the march taking 3 days, during which the weather was bad. The march was a good one, very few men falling out.

On the 19th. inst. the PRINCE of Wales visited the Battalion inspected the billets, and spoke to several of the men.

Leave is very plentiful and the men are enjoying visiting CHARLEROI, BRUSSELLS and places of interest.

The G. O. C., 1st. Division also visited the Battalion during the latter end of the month.

The health of the troops is good, although recently several cases of diarhoea have occurred and a few men evacuated.

Christmas was celebrated by Company Dinners, special Xmas fare being provided from the Regimental Funds and helped by the men themselves.

The Battalion is very comfortably billeted in VILLERS POTERIE, and the inhabitants are very friendly disposed.

Several N. C. Os. and men have left the Battalion for return to Australia, being 1914 and 1915 members.

Extract from 1st. Div. R.O. No. 781.

The following memorandum received from Administrative H. Q., A.I.F., London, embodying report furnished by A.P.M., A.I.F., London, is promulgated for information. It is desired that this report be read out to all mem on parado:

Trespectfully beg to report that there is a strong suspicion that many undesirable characters, both male and female, of the class that endeavour to cultivate acquaintance with members of the A.I.F. on leave in LOWDON, are at the present mement employing for the purpose of frugging and subsequent robbery, small tablets of the appearance of anotherine, which these individuals prefer for the use of any of our men in whose company they may be eating.

The action of whatever drug is contained in the above tablet is to produce almost immediate drossiness followed by complete stuper. On revival, a slight loss of memory frequently results and the victim has usually a confused recollection of the person with whom he has been in company, and of the circumstances of their meeting, and in fact, is incapable of giving any detailed account of what has transpired.

There is abundant cause to believe that several members of the A.I.F. in this city, who have recently been robbed of their wallets and paybooks, etc., and have been able to furnish practically no information as to the occurrence, have been victims to persons using the above tablets. I therefore respectfully beg to suggest that all members of the A.I.F. may be warned through the medium of A.I.F. Orders as to the advisability of accepting any so called Saccharine tablets preferred for their use by comparative strangers, in whose company they may happen to be."
