"	20		" Dull misty morn - Rain from midday	
Spoil bank	21		" Fine. Released 12 <sup>th</sup> A.I.T.M.B. - Relief completed at 5.30 pm. No Casualties.	
"	22		" Dull - drizzling rain. Between 9 & 10 pm. Munnerup observed firing from Lock 6 - no firing done.	
"	23		" Fine slight ground mist. At 8.20 am. Enemy aircraft engaged with 7.5 sized T.M. Shell - Results Satisfactory. At 4.40 pm No. 2 Mortar fired 10 rounds at <sup>Position</sup> Munnerup's <sup>Position</sup> carried yesterday.	
"	24		" Dull bright intervals. Mortars registered on enemy positions on Canal Bank with good results.	
"	25		" Dull cold rains. A few shots fired on enemy positions with good results.	
"	26		" Fine. A few rounds fired on munnerup's position - results satisfactory.	
"	27		" Dull showery intervals. "Stand too" from 10 pm till 5 am. A few rounds fired on enemy <sup>Position</sup> frannemurper position.	
"	28		" Cold - slight rain. Waited for enemy attack. Carried forward 200 rounds.
