

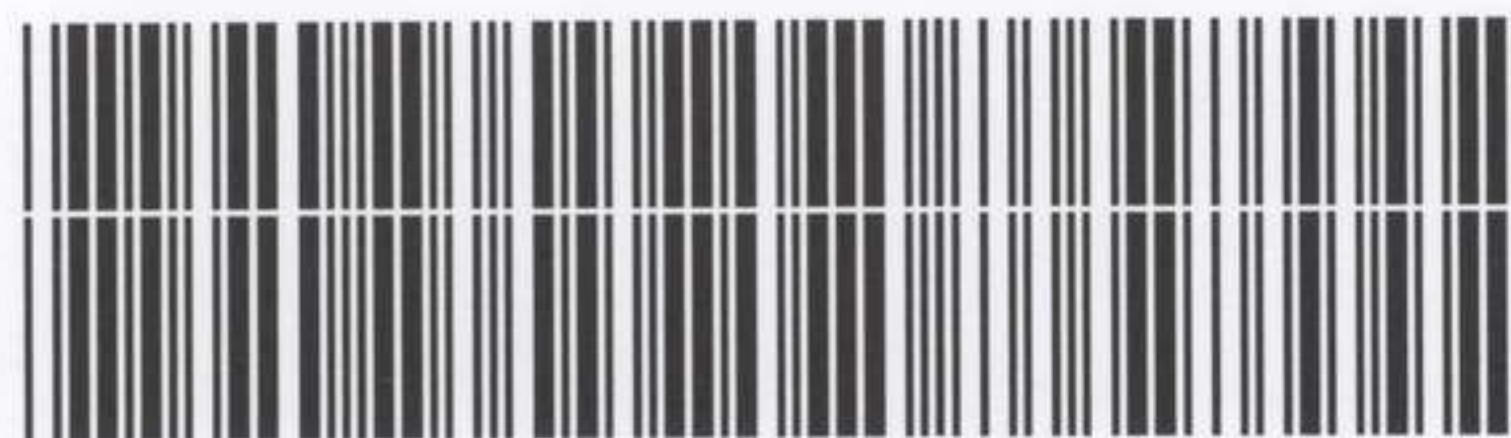



	11 <sup>th</sup> ANZAC 0000	27 <sup>th</sup> Bn. disembarked from SS "Partridge" & "Prince Abbas", left Beach party 2 off's + 108 others. Marched 2000 to Taylor's Hollow. Proceeded thence to Upper Cheshire Ridge & took over trenches gradually from NZMR Bde.	
	0900	28 <sup>th</sup> Bn. disembarked from SS "SARNIA", left a beach party of 2 off's + 105 others and bivouacked at Bauchop's Hill, proceeding thence <del>to</del> <sup>and took</sup> over the Apex from the NZ Inf Bde.
