

Necessary alterations to gun pits were made and teams made themselves generally comfortable. ditto Line slightly advanced. Days very quiet. STRENGTH - 4 Offs., 59 O. Ranks. LOCATION OF HEADQUARTERS - Dugout, south of Fouilloy, near Corbie.	
			Bright morning, dull towards afternoon.
