- GUARD. 1. C.S.M. will detail guard of 1 Sergt. 10 O.R. to report to Orderly Officer. Their duties will be to prevent men from leaving the train without permission of the Orderly Officer, who will be responsible that these orders are carried out at each stop.
- PARADE. 2. Unit will parade in full marching order at 1600 on the 6.11.18 and Route March to HANGEST via LONGPRE

All brakesmen must wear their equipment, and not hang it on the transport as is sometimes the case at present. No equipment (others) must be seen on any vehicle.

The clean polished neck chains must be worn on horse's necks, and not the old rusty ones as seen on some Unit's transport.

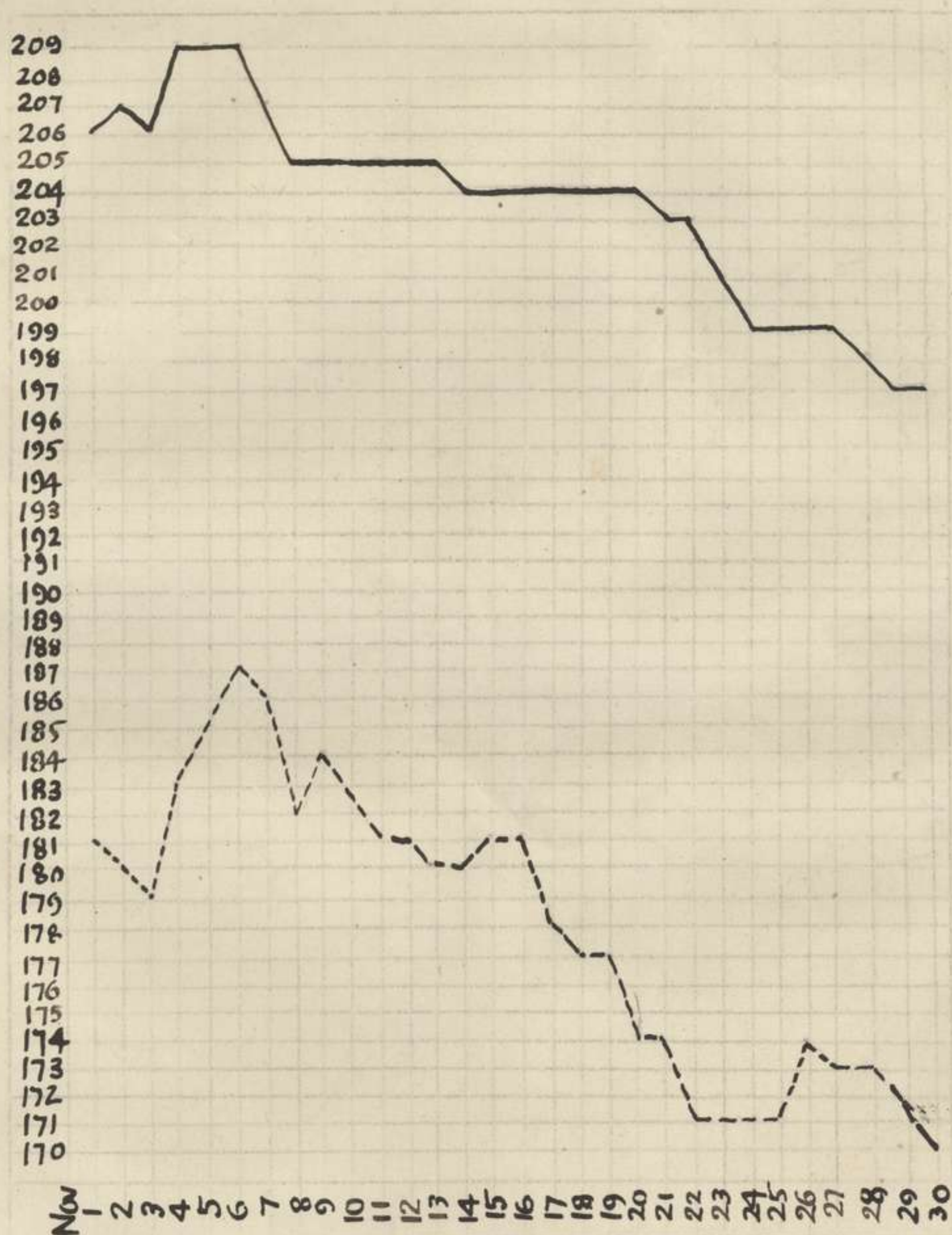

Nov. 1918

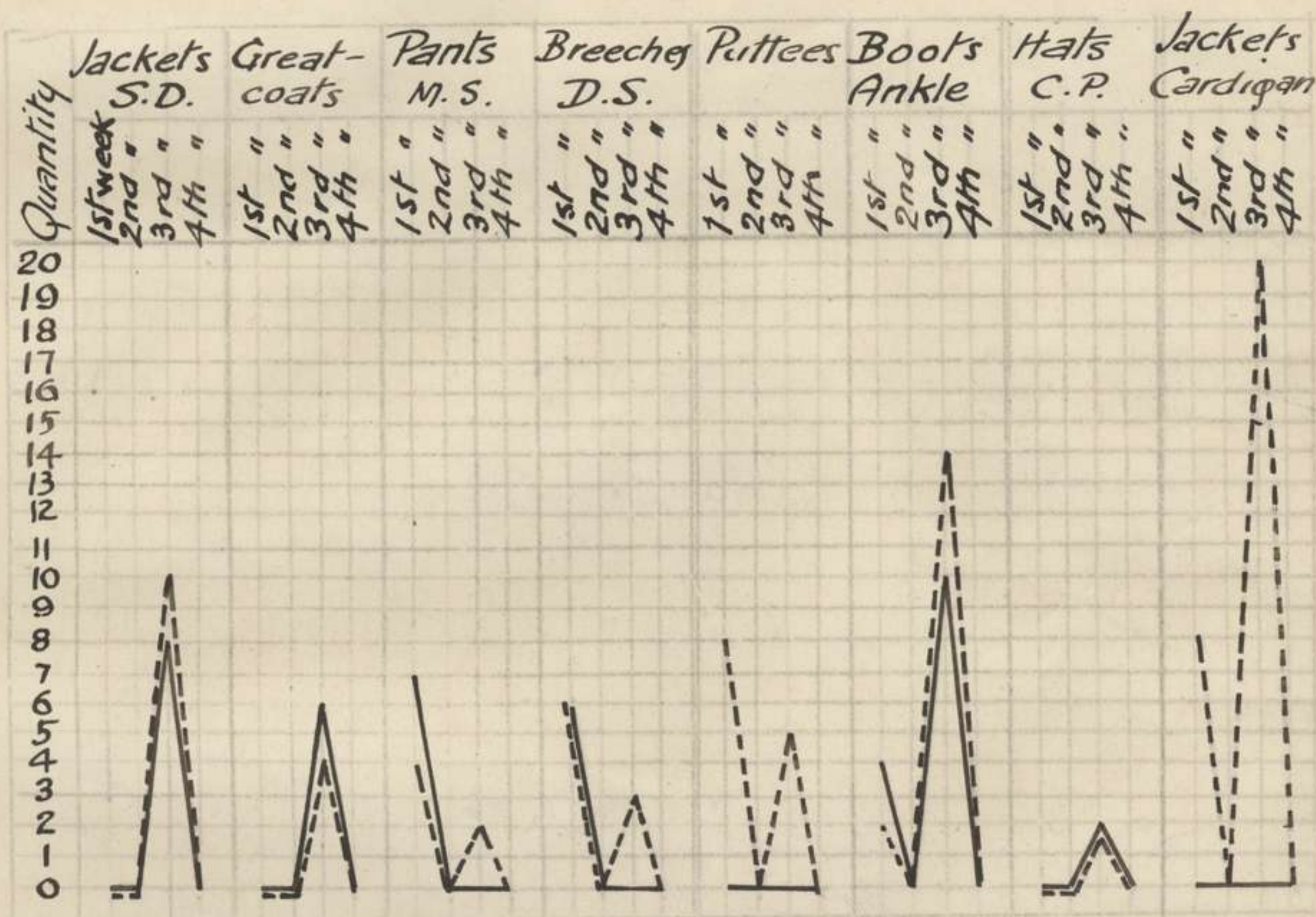

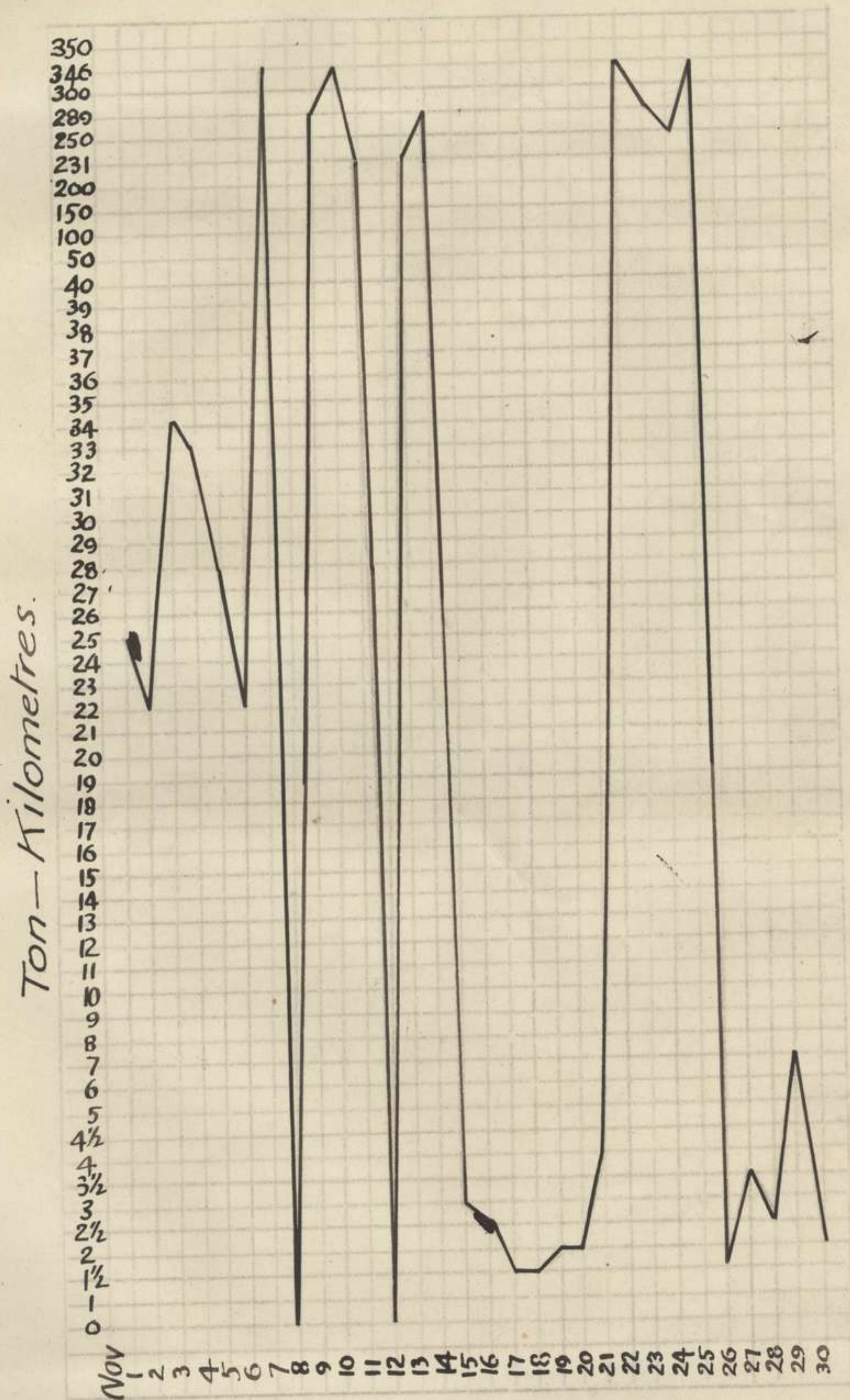

for November 1918



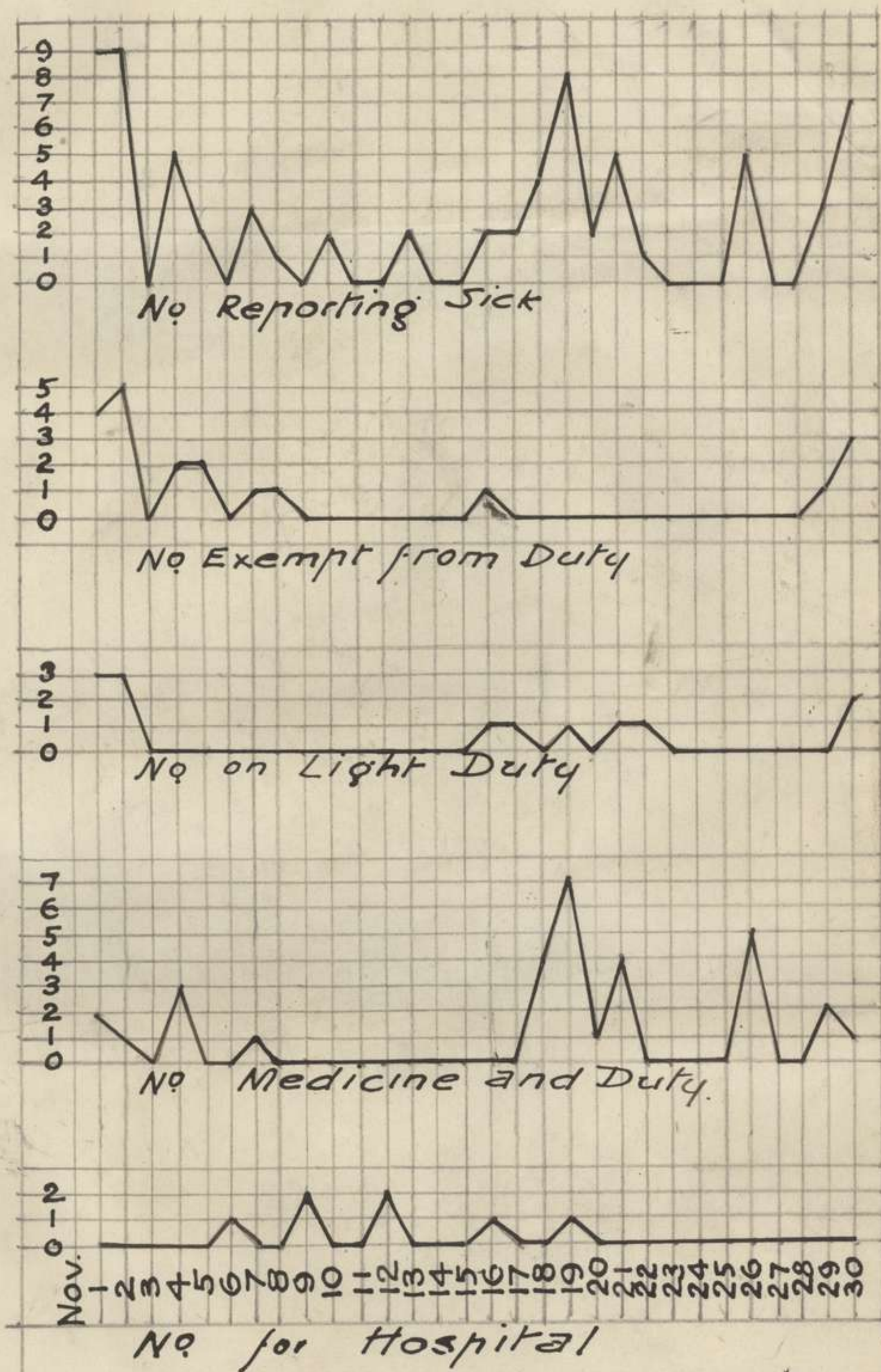
