MARCH TO THE RHINE.

INSTRUCTION No. 11.

Field Punishment and Safe Custody Compounds.

1. F.P.COMPOUND will not accompany the Corps in any forward move. No more men will be received at the Compound.

Divisions will at once notify the A.P.M. which men now serving sentences in the Compound they do not wish to rejoin their units. Arrangements will then be made for the disposal of these men and they will be sent, on completion of their sentences, to Corps Reinforcement Camp, MIANFAY via ABBEVILLE.

2. SAFE CUSTODY COMPOUND will also not accompany the Corps in any forward move.

No more men will be sent to the Safe Custody Compound.

A.P.M. will furnish a list of the men there to Divisions.

Divisions will arrange to dispose of the cases of men there without delay. A list of those who cannot be disposed of will be furnished to 'A' of Corps with an explanation against each, of the reason. Instructions as to their disposal will then be issued.

It is proposed to establish a Court to sit at the Compound for a week or less to dispose of as many cases as possible.

3. Divisions will at once prepare lists of bad characters whom they do not wish to accompany units - orders for their disposal will be issued as early as possible.

Steps have already been taken to prevent any further men rejoining their units under suspended sentences.

4. A.P.M. will advise 'A' of Corps when the respective Compounds are empty and instructions will then be issued for the disposal of the Staff there.
